To commend Louisiana State University Health Shreveport medical student Holly LaCour for her work to increase students' exposure to science.

WHEREAS, Holly LaCour is a third-year medical student at LSU Health Shreveport who has dedicated the past two years to expanding and improving IDEAS Day, a free day of science for students in north Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Holly's incredible leadership and outreach efforts over the last two years, IDEAS Day has grown from two hundred twelve attendees and thirty-five experiments to over five hundred attendees and more than sixty experiments; and

WHEREAS, in addition to playing a foundational role in growing IDEAS Day, Holly led a student team representing the LSU Health Shreveport School of Medicine at the 2023 Barksdale Air Force Base Air Show; she coordinated a two-day presence in the STARBASE Stem Zone, which featured more than thirty participating organizations and drew over two thousand attendees; and

WHEREAS, Ms. LaCour is also very active at LSU Health Shreveport School of Medicine; she serves as a counselor and activities chair for Camp Tiger, a week-long camp for children with mental and physical disabilities, and as a peer mentor for incoming students; she volunteers administering COVID-19 tests as a member of the LSU Health Shreveport COVID-19 Strike Team and serves in a number of other school organizations; and

1 WHEREAS, Ms. LaCour was honored in March 2022 with election into the Gold
2 Humanism Society for her compassion with patients and for serving as a role model, mentor,
3 and leader at LSU Health Shreveport; she is most deserving of the highest recognition for
4 her inspiring dedication to the service of others.

5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
6 commend Louisiana State University Health Shreveport medical student Holly LaCour for
7 her work to increase students' exposure to science and does hereby extend sincerest wishes
