Page 1 of 1 (Constitutional Amendment) Repeals provisions in the Louisiana Constitution related to various funds

Proposed constitutional amendment repeals provisions of the constitution which create special funds within the state treasury: Atchafalaya Basin Conservation Fund, Higher Education Louisiana Partnership Fund, Millennium Leverage Fund, Agricultural and Seafood Products Support Fund, First Use Tax Trust Fund, and Louisiana Investment Fund for Enhancement. Proposed constitutional amendment provides for the transfer of any remaining monies in such funds to the state general fund. To be submitted to the electors at the statewide election to be held on October 14, 2023.

A companion bill (HB 293) is the enabling legislation; however, proposed constitutional amendment repeals two funds which are not mentioned in HB 293: (1) the Higher Education Louisiana Partnership Fund, and (2) the First Use Tax Trust Fund.

There will be no net impact on state revenues due to the proposed constitutional amendment. The proposed constitutional amendment will transfer approximately \$604 Statutory Dedications out of the Louisiana Investment Fund for Enhancement and into the state general fund. The state treasury reports that all other funds repealed by the proposed constitutional amendment have balances of \$0.
