| 7 | WHEREAS, occupational therapists use a holistic approach to help people participate |
| 8 | in the things they want and need to do; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, the benefits of occupational therapy include reducing fall risks and |
| 10 | nursing home admissions, lowering readmission rates to hospitals, lowering rates of |
| 11 | depression, and improving quality of life for people with chronic disease; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, occupational therapists use the patient's active participation in |
| 13 | functional activities and simulated work tasks to improve the individual's function, making |
| 14 | them a more productive member of society by returning them to independence at work or |
| 15 | home; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, in the industrial setting, occupational therapists develop and implement |
| 17 | fit for duty and injury prevention programs, thereby keeping employees healthy and their |
| 18 | employers financially competitive. |
