



1           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
2 authorize and direct the Louisiana State Law Institute to study procedures in civil actions  
3 that require the mailing of notice with respect to the commencement of certain deadlines for  
4 answers or responses or for appearance before the court for certain motions and other  
5 hearings and to report its findings to the Legislature of Louisiana no later than February 1,  
6 2024.

7           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
8 director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.

9           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute shall submit  
10 one print copy and one electronic copy of any report produced pursuant to this Resolution  
11 to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library as required by R.S. 24:772.
