**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 282  
by Representative Green

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, delete "administration" and insert "reimbursement"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, after "Education;" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning  
5 of line 5, delete "Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt rules;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 and at the beginning of line 15, delete "program" and insert  
8 the following:

9 "(3)(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an  
10 eligible student"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete lines 16 through 19 and insert the following:

13 "(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, an eligible student is a student  
14 who meets the federal eligibility guidelines for reduced price meals by  
15 household size and income levels pursuant to the national school breakfast  
16 and school lunch programs.

17 (c) For each breakfast or lunch served free of charge in accordance  
18 with this Paragraph, the state Department of Education shall reimburse the  
19 governing authority of a nutrition program provider for the meal an amount  
20 equal to the difference between the reimbursement rates provided by the  
21 United States Department of Agriculture for a free meal and a reduced-price  
22 meal.

23 Section 2. The provisions of R.S. 17:192(B)(3) as enacted by this Act  
24 shall be implemented beginning with the 2023-2024 school year."
