Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 372 by Representative Edmonston

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "jurisdiction of certain" and insert "authority of"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 5, delete "communications from certain" and insert "regulations from"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 16 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 §20. Authority of federal and international organizations

8 Pursuant to the Tenth Amendment of the Constitution of the United States,
9 well settled United States Supreme Court precedent including Printz v United States,
10 521 U.S. 898 (1997) and Murphy v. Nat'l Collegiate Athletic Ass'n, 200 L. Ed. 2d
11 854 (2018), and Federalist Number forty-six, neither the federal government nor any
12 international organization shall have authority, directly or indirectly, to command
13 this state, or any agency, department, or political subdivision thereof, to enact,
14 enforce, or implement any federal or international regulatory program, as such
15 commands are fundamentally incompatible with our constitutional system of dual
16 sovereignty. Enforcement by the state of Louisiana of any federal or international
17 recommendations, instructions, or regulatory programs, including but not limited to
18 those issuing from the Centers for Disease Control and prevention and the World
19 Health Organization, shall be in the sole discretion of the state of Louisiana.
