Abstract: Requires a website to assist with cosmetology licensure and changes the requirements needed for cosmetology licensure.

Present law outlines the powers and duties of the La. State Board of Cosmetology (board).

Proposed law adds the requirement that the board create and maintain a website that allows applicants to apply, pay fees, and see their current status for cosmetology licensure.

Present law requires a course of practical training and technical instruction extending over a period of not less than nine months and including not less than 1500 hours for a cosmetology license.

Proposed law changes present law by reducing the hours needed for licensure to not less than seven months and 15 days consecutively and not less than 1200 hours of practical training.

Effective Aug. 1, 2024.
