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| HB 578 Engrossed     | 2023 Regular Session | Glover |
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Abstract: Establishes a program to encourage and assist the public to quit smoking.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that individuals may receive any of the smoking cessation benefits for a three-month period with all costs paid by private insurance, or Medicaid, if applicable. Smoking cessation benefits include but are not limited to nicotine patches, nicotine lozenges, and prescription drugs.

<u>Proposed law</u> directs the La. Department of Health to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to enforce the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.

Proposed law provides for definitions.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
