Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 9 by Representative Butler

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 5, delete lines 19 through 22 and at the beginning of line 23, change "(3)" to "(2)"3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 5, at the beginning of line 25, change "(4)" to "(3)"5 AMENDMENT NO. 36 On page 6, line 4, after "Paragraph" and before "of this" change "(A)(4)" to "(A)(3)"7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 7, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

9 "E.(1) Nothing in this Chapter shall be deemed to limit the
10 independence or autonomy of any participating school or service provider or
11 to make the actions of a participating school or service provider the actions
12 of the state government.13 (2) Participating schools and service providers shall be given
14 maximum freedom to provide for the educational needs of participating
15 students without governmental control.16 (3) Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to expand the
17 regulatory authority of the state, its officers, or any school district to impose
18 any additional regulation of participating schools or service providers beyond
19 those necessary to enforce the requirements of the program.20 (4) A participating school or service provider that accepts funds
21 pursuant to this Chapter is not an agent of the state or federal government.22 (5) No participating school or service provider shall be required to
23 alter its creed, practices, admissions policy, or curriculum in order to accept
24 account funds."
