5 Opelousas, Louisiana, and had the opportunity to play with the Eunice Symphony Orchestra;  
6 despite these many honors, he remained incredibly humble throughout his life; and

7           WHEREAS, Ronnie Matthew LeMaire leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Carrie  
8 K. LeMaire; granddaughter, Brooke Champagne; great-grandchildren, Matthew and Joseph  
9 Marceaux; stepchildren, Charlotte Fox, and her husband Shawn, Cindy Langley, and Trey  
10 Langley, and his wife Sheree; step-grandchildren, Carrie Soileau, Brett Soileau, Jonathan  
11 Fox, Payton Fox, Elizabeth Fox, Shelton Langley, and Faye Langley; and step-great-  
12 grandson, Everen Soileau; he will be deeply missed but certainly never forgotten.

13           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
14 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express heartfelt condolences on the death of Ronnie  
15 Matthew LeMaire; does hereby express sincere appreciation for his service as a member of
