<u>Present law</u> provides that when any communications district is created wholly within a single parish, the parish governing authority creating it may appoint a board of commissioners composed of seven members to govern its affairs and shall fix the domicile of the board at any point within the parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that members of the East Baton Rouge Parish Communications District board may appoint a designee in the event a member of the board cannot attend a meeting.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
