Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to
Original House Bill No. 149 by Representative Marino

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "507(B)" delete the comma "," and insert "and to enact R.S.
3 24:31.7.1,"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the end of line 3, after "members of the legislature; to" insert "allow any
6 member or member-elect to waive all or part of any salary or other compensation; to"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "reenacted" insert "and R.S. 24:31.7.1 is hereby enacted"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 2, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

11 "§31.7.1. Waiver of salary or compensation

12 A.(1) A member or member-elect of the legislature may waive all or any
13 portion of the salary or other compensation for his service in the legislature. Any
14 member or member-elect who chooses to waive all or any portion of the salary or
15 other compensation for his service in the legislature shall submit to the payroll
16 officer of his house of the legislature an affidavit containing his name, the date, and
17 a statement of the fact that he is waiving all or a portion of his salary or
18 compensation at least fourteen days prior to the commencement of the next pay
19 period.

20 (2) Upon receipt of the affidavit as provided in this Subsection, the payroll
21 officer shall ensure that the member of legislature is paid or compensated at the
22 salary or compensation indicated in the affidavit beginning at the commencement of
23 the next pay period.

24 B.(1) If the member of legislature decides to change the amount of the salary
25 or compensation he receives after having waived all or any portion thereof, the
26 member of legislature shall, at least fourteen days prior to the commencement of the
27 next pay period, submit to the payroll officer of his house of the legislature an
28 affidavit containing his name, the date, and a statement of fact that he is revoking his
29 previous affidavit and the amount of the salary or compensation he chooses to
30 receive.

31 (2) Upon receipt of the affidavit as provided in this Subsection, the payroll
32 officer shall ensure that the member of legislature is paid or compensated at the
33 salary or compensation indicated in the affidavit beginning at the commencement of
34 the next pay period.
