On page 1, line 5, after "program;" and before "and to" insert "to provide for effectiveness;"

AMENDMENT NO. 2On page 1, line 9, after "§2508." and before "creation;" delete "Louisiana Imagination  
Library Program and Fund;" and insert "Imagination Library of Louisiana and fund;"AMENDMENT NO. 3On page 1, line 10, after "A. The" and before "is hereby" delete "Louisiana Imagination  
Library Program" and insert "Imagination Library of Louisiana"AMENDMENT NO. 4On page 1, line 15, after "B.(1)" and before "authority" delete "The" insert "Subject to  
appropriation of funds by the legislature as provided in Subsection C of this Section, the"AMENDMENT NO. 5On page 2, line 15, after "with" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line  
16, delete "Broadcasting" and insert "an organization that provides age-appropriate books  
to children ages birth to five years old on a monthly basis"AMENDMENT NO. 6On page 2, line 17, after "The" and before "Fund," delete "Louisiana Imagination Library"  
and insert "Imagination Library of Louisiana"AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 2, between lines 21 and 22, insert the following:

"(3) All monies appropriated by the legislature or designated to the fund  
through donation, gift, grant, or any other revenue shall be deposited in the fund.  
Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies are invested in  
the state general fund. Interest earned on investment of monies in the funds shall be  
credited to the fund."

AMENDMENT NO. 8On page 2, at the beginning of line 22, delete "(3)" and insert "(4)"AMENDMENT NO. 9

On page 2, after line 27, insert the following:

"Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor  
or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law  
without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the

1 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by  
2 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
