Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 282 by Representative Green

1 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, delete "administration" and insert "reimbursement"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 4, after "Education;" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning
of line 5, delete "Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt rules;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 and at the beginning of line 15, delete "program" and insert
the following:

9 "(3)(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an eligible 10 student"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete lines 16 through 19 and insert the following:

13 "(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, an eligible student is a student who meets the federal eligibility guidelines for reduced price meals by household size and 14 15 income levels pursuant to the national school breakfast and school lunch programs. 16 (c) For each breakfast or lunch served free of charge in accordance with this Paragraph, the state Department of Education shall reimburse the governing 17 18 authority of a nutrition program provider for the meal an amount equal to the 19 difference between the reimbursement rates provided by the United States 20 Department of Agriculture for a free meal and a reduced-price meal. Section 2. The provisions of R.S. 17:192(B)(3) as enacted by this Act shall 21

be implemented beginning with the 2023-2024 school year."
