and recognizes his outstanding achievements

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the death of Donald
3 Gifford "Don" Briggs and to recognize his outstanding achievements.

4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the Legislature of
5 Louisiana has learned of the passing, on April 3, 2023, of Donald Gifford "Don" Briggs; and

6 WHEREAS, Don was born on December 30, 1940, in Miami, Florida, to Anna Mae
7 and Willis Gifford Briggs, and he lived in Lafayette, Louisiana, for more than sixty years;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Don was a renaissance man who enjoyed a successful high school
10 football career that continued at Florida State University; he also had a brief but successful
11 modeling career that saw him featured in several national publications; and

12 WHEREAS, Don began his decades-long career in the oil and gas industry as a
13 roustabout for Owen Drilling Company working from 6:00 PM until midnight, seven days
14 a week; he worked his way up to safety director, and by the 1970s, he owned Aztec
15 Companies; and

16 WHEREAS, Don founded Louisiana Independent Oil and Gas Association, now
17 known as Louisiana Oil and Gas Association (LOGA), in 1992; the initial group of twelve
18 founding members has grown into an association that represents more than twelve hundred
19 members; and

1 WHEREAS, Don was the face and voice of the oil and gas industry, as president of
2 LOGA, for more than twenty-five years; he was a fierce advocate for the industry and
3 worked tirelessly to educate public and government officials about how critical the industry
4 is to Louisiana and its economy; and

5 WHEREAS, Don was named "LAGCOE Looey" in 2017 and received the
6 Meritorious Service Award from the Professional Landmen's Association of New Orleans;
7 he was a titan of the oil and gas industry and a Louisiana legend whose legacy of building
8 and safeguarding oil and gas operations in the state cannot be overstated nor forgotten; and

9 WHEREAS, Don was a devoted father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and caring
10 friend to many; his hobbies included fishing in the Florida Keys, working in his vegetable
11 garden, photography, duck hunting, and traveling; and

12 WHEREAS, Don was a family man, cherishing years of memories with his children
13 and grandchildren; however, the center of his life was his wife of twenty-five years, Nanette
14 Benoit "Nan" Briggs; throughout their marriage, they enjoyed biking, dining out, dancing,
15 and trips with friends and family to the mountains in North Carolina; and

16 WHEREAS, Don was a culinary enthusiast and his lasting legacy of a "Don Briggs
17 Special" can be found at restaurants across Louisiana, from Mansurs on the Boulevard in
18 Baton Rouge to La Fonda in Lafayette; and

19 WHEREAS, Don cemented his legacy in 2022 when he became a published author,
20 sharing the story of his life, faith, and trials in *Isn't it Beautiful: The Story of Don Briggs*;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, Don was also a devout Catholic who served many years through his
23 Bird Feeder Ministry and as a Eucharistic minister at Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital and
24 various local nursing home; and

25 WHEREAS, Donald Gifford Briggs truly loved serving others; he leaves to cherish
26 his memory his children, Tammy Milam, and her husband Mark, Brett Briggs, Andon
27 Briggs, and his wife Beth, and Gifford Briggs, and his wife Jackie; grandchildren, Colby
28 Briggs, Devin Briggs, and his wife Kati, Sara Noel, and her husband Taylor, Summer Simm,
29 and her husband Alex, Parker Briggs, Gentry Briggs, Ash Briggs, Chloe Briggs, and Max
30 Briggs; great-grandchildren, Jesse Briggs, Marci Briggs, Sailor Noel, Piper Ann Noel, and

1 Alden Simm; sister, Deanna O'Brien; and brother, Stephen Briggs, and his wife Joan; Don
2 will be deeply missed but certainly never forgotten.
