1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 10, after "investigation" delete "of the facts surrounding the death"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 17, on page 2, delete line 1, and insert the following:
- "C. If the investigation reveals suspicious circumstances or the reasonable
 probability of the commission of a crime, the coroner shall deny the permit <u>until the</u>
 <u>coroner's investigation is completed</u>. After completion of the coroner's investigation, he may issue a permit for cremation.
- D. Upon completion of the coroner's investigation, the coroner shall release the body to the family or friends for disposition in accordance with R.S. 13:5715. In any case under coroner jurisdiction in which the body cannot be released within thirty days of death, the coroner shall notify in writing the person or persons with the right to dispose of human remains under R.S. 8:655 the reasons for any delay in release of the body."
