CONSTITUTION/AMENDMENT: (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the use of monies from a foreign government or nongovernmental source to fund elections

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION		
2	Proposing to add Article XI, Section 6 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to generally prohibit		
3	the use of funds and resources from a foreign government or a nongovernmenta		
4	source for the conduct of elections and for the functions and duties established in the		
5	election code except under specified circumstances; to provide for submission of the		
6	proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related matters.		
7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members		
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of		
9	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add		
10	Article XI, Section 6 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:		
11	§6. Use of Monies, Goods, or Services for Conduct of Elections; Prohibitions		
12	Section 6. Except as otherwise specifically provided by law, no funds, goods,		
13	or services donated by a foreign government or a nongovernmental source shall be		
14	used for any function or duty established in the election code or to conduct an		
15	election unless the use is authorized by the secretary of state in accordance with		
16	policies established in accordance with law.		
17	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted		
18	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on October 14,		
19	2023.		

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,		
2	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted		
3	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read a		
4	follows:		
5	Do you support an amendment to prohibit the use of funds, goods, or services		
6	from a foreign government or a nongovernmental source to conduct elections		
7	and election functions and duties unless the use is authorized by the secretary		
8	of state through policies established in accordance with law? (Adds Article		
9	XI, Section 6)

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Abstract: Prohibits the use of funds and resources from a foreign government or a nongovernmental source for the conduct of elections and for the functions and duties related to the administration and conduct of elections as provided in the election code except as specifically authorized by law or by the secretary of state in accordance with policies established in accordance with law.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that the legislature shall adopt an election code providing for the permanent registration of voters and for the conduct of all elections.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> prohibits except as otherwise specifically provided by law, funds, goods, or services donated by a foreign government or a nongovernmental source from being used for any function or duty established in the election code or to conduct an election unless the use is authorized by the secretary of state in accordance with policies established in accordance with law.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 14, 2023.
