GAMBLING/CHARITABLE: Provides relative to licenses for certain raffle games

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a limited raffle license for certain raffle games. Requires the office of charitable gaming within the Dept. of Revenue to promulgate rules relative to the issuance of such licenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 4:705(2)(c)) and 714(F)(1)), relative to the establishment, assessment, and collection of certain fees and proceeds from gaming sessions deposited into a bank account, shall not apply to any limited license issued pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> applies only to single raffle games as defined in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 4:707(A)(1)), with the prize value of which does not exceed \$5,000.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Provide that <u>proposed law</u> only applies to single raffle games as defined in <u>present law</u>, the proceeds of which shall not exceed \$10,000.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to the reengrossed bill

1. Removes applicability <u>from</u> proceeds not to exceed \$10,000 to prize value not to exceed \$5,000.
