BY SENATOR FIELDS

SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Authorizes the creation of cooperative economic development districts affiliated with Southern University and Louisiana State University in East Baton Rouge Parish. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:9038.75, relative to cooperative economic development in and around
3 Southern University and Louisiana State University in East Baton Rouge Parish; to
4 provide for the creation of special taxing districts for such purposes; to provide for
5 the governance and powers and duties of such a district, including the authority to
6 levy taxes and special assessments; to authorize such a district to incur debt and to
7 pledge tax increments to repayment thereof; and to provide for related matters.

8 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

10 Section 1. R.S. 33:9038.75 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

11 **§9038.75. College economic development districts**

12 **A.(1) There is hereby created in East Baton Rouge Parish, in which**
13 **Southern University and Louisiana State University are located, both hereafter**
14 **in this Section referred to as a "college", the Southern University Economic**
15 **Development District and the Louisiana State University Economic**
16 **Development District that includes property owned by either of these**
17 **institutions to provide for cooperative economic and community development**

1 among the district, the college, the local governmental subdivision, the state,
2 and the owners of property in the district. Hereafter in this Section, the terms
3 "college economic development district" or "district" refer to a district created
4 pursuant to this Section. Any college economic development district is a political
5 subdivision of the state having all of the rights, powers, privileges, and
6 immunities accorded by law and the Constitution of Louisiana to political
7 subdivisions of the state, subject to the limitations provided in this Section.

8 B.(1)(a) Boundaries for the LSU Economic Development District. The
9 LSU Economic Development District ("LSU EDD") generally encompasses an
10 area within the City of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, an area generally bounded to
11 the north by Old South Baton Rouge, City Park, University Gardens
12 Subdivision, to the south by Brightside Lane, to the west by the East Baton
13 Rouge Parish line, and to the east by Stanford Avenue, West Parker Boulevard
14 and Nicholson Drive, subject to, and less and except, the exclusions as defined
15 below ("District Exclusions"), and being more fully described as follows:

16 Commence at a point which is the intersection of the westward
17 projection of the LSU campus northern property line with the East Baton
18 Rouge Parish line located in the Mississippi River, being the point of beginning;
19 Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of the
20 LSU campus property to its intersection with the east right of way line of the
21 ICRR railroad; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the east right
22 of way line of the ICRR right of way line to a point within the Nicholson
23 Gateway area, which point has Louisiana State Plane South Zone coordinates
24 of X:3326534, Y:695397; Thence proceed through the Nicholson Gateway area
25 N 84° 51' E a distance of 291' more or less to a point; Thence proceed through
26 the Nicholson Gateway area N 07° 15' W a distance of 432' more or less to a
27 point; Thence proceed through the Nicholson Gateway area N 71° 29' E a
28 distance of 168' more or less to a point located on the west right of way line of
29 Nicholson Drive; Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the west right

1 of way line of Nicholson Drive to its intersection with the south right of way line
2 of West Chimes Street; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the south
3 right of way line of West Chimes Street to its intersection with the east right of
4 way line of Alaska Street, said point also being 20 feet east of the centerline of
5 the street on the LSU campus commonly known as Cypress Drive; Thence
6 proceed southerly and easterly direction on a line parallel to and north of the
7 centerline of said Cypress Drive to its intersection with a point that is 20 feet
8 north of the centerline of Cypress Drive at its intersection with Dalrymple
9 Drive; Thence proceed in a northerly direction at a right angle to the centerline
10 of Cypress Drive a distance of 20 feet to a point that is 40 feet north of the
11 centerline of Dalrymple Drive; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along
12 a line that is 40 feet north of and parallel to the centerline of Dalrymple Drive
13 to a point located east of the southeast corner of the Pentagon Dormitory area,
14 which point has Louisiana State Plane South Zone coordinates of X:3328695,
15 Y:696758; Thence proceed in a northerly direction through the LSU campus
16 property N 22° 46' E a distance of 282 feet more or less to a point; Thence
17 proceed in a northwesterly direction through the LSU campus property N 53°
18 57' W a distance of 240 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a
19 northwesterly direction through the LSU campus property N 70° 58' W a
20 distance of 140 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a northerly
21 direction through the LSU campus property N 02° 17' W a distance of 291 feet
22 more or less to a point; Thence proceed in an easterly direction through the
23 LSU campus property N 87° 34' E a distance of 192 feet more or less to a point;
24 Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction through the LSU campus property
25 S 37° 03' E a distance of 188 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in an
26 easterly direction through the LSU campus property S 87° 19' E a distance of
27 380 feet more or less to the southwest corner of Lot A-2-A of the former Antonio
28 Lasavio Property; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the south line
29 of Lot A-2-A of the former Antonio Lasavio Property to the southeast corner of

1 said Lot A-2-A of the former Antonio Lasavio Property; Thence proceed in a
2 northerly direction along the east line of Lots A-2-A, A-2-B, A-2-C and A-2-D
3 of the former Antonio Lasavio Property to the northeast corner of said Lot A-2-
4 D of the former Antonio Lasavio Property; Thence proceed in a westerly
5 direction along the north line of Lot A-2-D of the former Antonio Lasavio
6 Property to the northwest corner of said Lot A-2-D of the former Antonio
7 Lasavio Property; Thence proceed in a northerly direction along a line which
8 is an extension of the westerly line of Lots A-2-A, A-2-B, A-2-C and A-2-D of the
9 former Antonio Lasavio Property a distance of 115.12' to a point; Thence
10 proceed in an easterly direction along a line which is parallel to the northerly
11 line of Lot A-2-D of the former Antonio Lasavio Property a distance of 330.59'
12 to a point which is the east line of a former access servitude; Thence proceed in
13 a southerly direction along a line which is parallel to the easterly line of Lot A-
14 2-D of the former Antonio Lasavio Property, which line is the east line of a
15 former access servitude to its intersection with the north right of way line of
16 West State Street; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the north right
17 of way line of West State Street to the southeast corner of Tract A-2-A of the
18 former Losavio Realty Property; Thence proceed in a northerly direction along
19 the east line of said Tract A-2-A of the Losavio Realty Property to the northeast
20 corner of said Tract A-2-A; Thence proceed in a westerly direction along the
21 north line of said Tract A-2-A of the Losavio Realty Property to the northwest
22 corner of said Tract A-2-A being the east right of way line of Spruce Lane;
23 Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the east right of way line of
24 Spruce Lane to the intersection of the south right of way line of Aster Street
25 with the east right of way line of Spruce Lane; Thence proceed in a westerly
26 direction along the south right of way line of Aster Street to its intersection with
27 the east right of way line of Alaska Street; Thence proceed in a northerly
28 direction along the east right of way line of Alaska Street to the southwest
29 corner of Lot 7, Sq. G, University Terrace Subdivision; Thence proceed in an

1 easterly direction along the south line of Lot 7, Sq. G, University Terrace to the
2 southeast corner of Lot 7; Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the
3 east line of Lots 1 thru 7, Sq. G, University Terrace Subdivision to the
4 intersection with the south right of way line of West Roosevelt Street; Thence
5 proceed in an easterly direction along the south right of way line of West
6 Roosevelt Street to the northeast corner of University Terrace School; Thence
7 proceed in a southerly direction along the east line of University Terrace School
8 a distance of 464 feet more or less to the southwest corner of the Edward J. Gay
9 Apartment Complex; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the south
10 line of the Edward J. Gay Apartment Complex a distance of 484 feet more or
11 less to a point located 20 feet east of the centerline of Spruce Lane; Thence
12 proceed in a northerly direction along a line that is 20 feet east of and parallel
13 to the centerline of Spruce Lane a distance of 462 feet more or less to its
14 intersection with the south right of way line of West Roosevelt Street; Thence
15 proceed in an easterly direction along the south right of way line of West
16 Roosevelt Street, extending across Highland Road to the east right of way line
17 of Highland Rd; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the east right
18 of way line of Highland Road to the south line of Tract Z-0, South Baton Rouge;
19 Thence proceed southeasterly along the south line of Tract Z-0, South Baton
20 Rouge to a point which is on a line which is the northerly extension of the
21 westerly line of Lot 12 Sq. A, Arbour Place; Thence proceed in a southeasterly
22 direction along a line which is the northerly extension of the westerly line of Lot
23 12 Sq. A, Arbour Place to the northwest corner of Lot 12 Sq. A, Arbour Place;
24 Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the north line of Arbour
25 Place to the northwest corner of Lot 10 Sq. A, Arbour Place; Thence proceed
26 in a southeasterly direction along the west line of Lot 10 Sq. A, Arbour Place to
27 the north right of way line of East State Street; Thence proceed in a
28 northeasterly direction along the north right of way line of East State Street to
29 its intersection with the west right of way line of Dalrymple Drive; Thence

1 proceed in a northeasterly direction along the west right of way line of
2 Dalrymple Drive to the northeast corner of Lot A of Lot 27, Richland
3 Plantation; Thence proceed in a westerly direction along the north line of Lot
4 A and Lot B-2 of Lot 27, Richland Plantation to the southeast corner of Lot Y
5 of the G.A. Peterkin property; Thence proceed in a northeasterly direction
6 along the east line of Lot Y and Z of the G.A. Peterkin property to the south line
7 of lot 8-A-1-A-1 Sq. 6, Lake Crest Subdivision; Thence proceed in a
8 southeasterly direction along the south line of Lots 1 through 8-A-1-A-1-A Sq.
9 6, Lake Crest Subdivision to the west right of way line of Dalrymple Drive;
10 Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the west right of way line of
11 Dalrymple Drive to its intersection of the north edge of the westbound roadway
12 of Interstate 10, as it existed in April of 2023; Thence proceed in a northwesterly
13 direction along the northern edge of the westbound roadway of Interstate 10,
14 as it existed in April of 2023, until its intersection with the northern edge of the
15 Interstate 10 on-ramp from Dalrymple Drive, as it existed in April of 2023;
16 Thence proceed in a northeasterly direction along the north right of way line of
17 the Interstate 10 on-ramp from Dalrymple Drive as it existed in April of 2023
18 and its extension to its intersection with the west right of way line of Dalrymple
19 Drive; Thence proceed in an easterly direction across Dalrymple Drive to a
20 point which is 30 feet east of the centerline of Dalrymple Drive as it existed in
21 April of 2023; Thence proceed in a southerly direction along a line which is 30
22 feet east of and parallel to the centerline of Dalrymple Drive as it existed in
23 April of 2023 to a point having Louisiana State Plane South Zone coordinates
24 of X=3332749, Y=701516; Thence proceed in an easterly direction N 88° 01' E
25 a distance of 32 feet more or less to a point on the existing water's edge of City
26 Park Lake as it existed in April of 2023; Thence proceed in a general
27 southeasterly direction following along the various meanders of the water's edge
28 of City Park Lake as it existed in April of 2023, through and including the small
29 adjoining lake commonly known as Lake Erie, continuing on through where

1 City Park Lake connects with University Lake as they existed in April of 2023,
2 continuing through University Lake (Excluding the peninsula that extends
3 westward, into the University Lake, formerly known as the Hal Phillips
4 property, commonly known as the Bird Sanctuary as it existed in April of 2023)
5 on a line coincident with the existing adjacent East Lakeshore Drive roadway,
6 continuing through to its intersection with the water's edge adjacent to Stanford
7 Ave, continuing along the water's edge adjacent to the west right of way line of
8 Stanford Ave, around the condominium formerly known as Stanford on the
9 Point, to the water's edge adjacent to South Lakeshore Drive, thence continuing
10 westerly and then southerly around the peninsula which comprises Magnolia
11 Ridge Subdivision, to its intersection with the west right of way line of Stanford
12 Avenue; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the west right of
13 way line of Stanford Avenue to its intersection with the south right of way line
14 of West Lakeshore Drive; Thence proceed in a westerly direction along the
15 south right of way line of West Lakeshore Drive to a point which intersects the
16 northerly extension of the west right of way line of Princeton Avenue as it was
17 originally platted in 1923; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the
18 west right of way line of Princeton Avenue as it was originally platted in 1923,
19 to the original northeast corner of Lot 6 Sq. 14, College Town Subdivision;
20 Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction thru College Lake to the most
21 northerly corner of Lot 8 Sq. 14, College Town Subdivision; Thence proceed in
22 a westerly direction along the northerly line of remaining portion of Lot 1 Sq.
23 14 College Town Subdivision to its intersection with the north right of way line
24 of Harvard Avenue as it was originally platted; Thence proceed in a
25 southwesterly direction with the north right of way line of Harvard Avenue as
26 it was originally platted to the northeast corner of Le Havre Townhome
27 Community; Thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the north line
28 of Le Harve Townhome Community to its intersection with the east right of way
29 line of East Parker Boulevard; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction

1 along the east right of way line of East Parker Boulevard to its intersection with
2 the north right of way line of Highland Road; Thence proceed in a southeasterly
3 direction along the north right of way line of Highland Road to its intersection
4 with the west right of way line of LSU Avenue; Thence proceed in a
5 southwesterly direction across Highland Road to the southeast corner of the
6 former Gulf Oil Corporation property located on the south side of Highland
7 Road; Thence proceed in a southwesterly, then westerly, then northeasterly
8 direction around the perimeter of the former Gulf Oil Corporation property
9 and Tract A-1-A of a Portion of the Materiste property until it intersects with
10 the south right of way line of Highland Road; Thence proceed in a
11 northwesterly direction along the south right of way line of Highland Road until
12 it intersects with the east right of way line of West Parker Boulevard; Thence
13 proceed in a southwesterly direction along the east right of way line of West
14 Parker Boulevard to its intersection with the north right of way line of Burbank
15 Drive; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the north right of way
16 line of Burbank Drive across East Boyd Drive to its intersection with the east
17 right of way line of East Boyd Drive; Thence proceed in a northeasterly
18 direction along the east right of way line of East Boyd Drive to the most
19 northerly corner of Lot 7 Block 12 University View Homesites; Thence proceed
20 in a southeasterly direction along the north line of said Lot 7 Block 12
21 University View Homesites to the most easterly corner of said Lot 7 Block 12
22 University View Homesites; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along
23 the east line of said Block 12 University View Homesites across Burbank Drive
24 to the most southerly corner of Lot S Block 12 University View Homesites;
25 Thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the south line of said Lot S
26 Block 12 University View Homesites to the southwest corner of said Lot S Block
27 12 University View Homesites located on the east right of way line of East Boyd
28 Drive; Thence proceed in a westerly direction across East Boyd Drive to the
29 southeast corner of Tract 2A-3 of the James T. Amiss Property, which is located

1 on the west right of way line of East Boyd Drive; Thence proceed in a
2 northwesterly direction along the southwesterly line of Tracts 2A-3 and 2A-2 of
3 the said James T. Amiss Property to the most westerly corner of said Tract 2A-2
4 of the said James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a northeasterly
5 direction along the northwesterly line of Tracts 2A-2 of the said James T. Amiss
6 Property to the most northerly corner of said Tract 2A-2 of the James T. Amiss
7 Property, which is located on the south right of way line of Burbank Drive;
8 Thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the south right of way line
9 of Burbank Drive to the most northerly corner of Tract 2A-1-A-1-A of the
10 James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a southerly, then westerly, then
11 northwesterly direction of the south line of Tracts 2A-1-A-1-A and 2A-1-A-1-C-
12 1 of the James T. Amiss Property to the most northerly corner of Tract 2A-1-A-
13 1-C-2-B of the James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a southeasterly
14 direction along the east line of Tract 2A-1-A-1-C-2-B of the said James T. Amiss
15 Property, continuing along the said line along its extension until it intersects the
16 northerly line of Tract 2A-1-A-1-C-3-A-1-A-1 of the James T. Amiss Property;
17 Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the north line of Tract 2A-1-
18 A-1-C-3-A-1-A-1 of the James T. Amiss Property to the north right of way line
19 of Nicholson Dr.; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the north
20 right of way line of Nicholson Dr. to the most southerly corner of Tract 2A-1-A-
21 1-C-3-A-1-A-1 of the James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a
22 northeasterly direction along the east line of Tracts 2A-1-A-1-C-3-A-1-A-1 of
23 the James T. Amiss Property to the most easterly corner of Tract 2A-1-A-1-C-3-
24 A-1-A-1 of the said James T. Amiss Property; Thence continue in a
25 southeasterly direction along the extension of the east line of Tract 2A-1-A-1-C-
26 3-A-1-A-1 of the James T. Amiss Property to its intersection with the southeast
27 line of Tract 2A-1-A-2-A-1-B-1 of the James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed
28 in a southwesterly direction along the southeast line of Tract 2A-1-A-2-A-1-B-1
29 of the James T. Amiss Property to the most northerly corner of Tract 2B-1-B

1 of the James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction
2 along the northeast line of Tracts 2B-1-B, 2B-1-C and Tract 1 of the James T.
3 Amiss Property and its extension to the east right of way line of East Boyd
4 Drive; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the east right of way
5 line of East Boyd Drive to the most northerly corner of Tracts 2-A-1 of the
6 James T. Amiss Property; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the
7 northeast line of Tract 2-A-1 of the James T. Amiss Property to the most
8 easterly corner of Tract 2-A-1 of the said James T. Amiss Property; Thence
9 proceed in a southwesterly direction along the southeast line of Tract 2-A-1 of
10 the James T. Amiss Property to the most northerly corner of Lot 1 University
11 South Subdivision; Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the
12 northeast line of Lot 1 University South Subdivision to a point on the west right
13 of way line of Jennifer Jean Drive; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction
14 along the west right of way line of Jennifer Jean Drive to its intersection with
15 the east right of way line of Nicholson Drive; Thence proceed in a southeasterly
16 direction along the east right of way line of Nicholson Drive to a point which is
17 on a line of the extension of the north line of an existing drainage right of way
18 located on the west side of Nicholson Drive, which line is also an extension of the
19 most southerly line of Tigerland Acres Subdivision; Thence proceed in a
20 westerly direction across Nicholson Drive along a line being the extension of the
21 said north line of an existing drainage right of way located on the west side of
22 Nicholson Drive, to the southeast corner of Tigerland Acres Subdivision;
23 Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the easterly line of Lots 1 through
24 12 of Tigerland Acres Subdivision to the northeast corner of Lot 1, said
25 Tigerland Acres Subdivision; Thence proceed in an easterly direction along the
26 southerly line of Lot B-2 of Tigerland Acres Subdivision to the eastern corner
27 of Tract X of Tigerland Acres Subdivision, said point being on the west right of
28 way line of the Illinois Central Railroad right of way; Thence proceed in a
29 northwesterly direction along the west right of way line of the Illinois Central

1 Railroad right of way to the most northerly corner of Lot B-2 of Tigerland
2 Acres Subdivision; Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the
3 northerly line of Lot B-2 of Tigerland Acres Subdivision to a point on the east
4 right of way line of Alvin Dark Avenue; Thence proceed in a northerly direction
5 along the east right of way line of Alvin Dark Avenue to its intersection with the
6 south right of way line of Bob Pettit Boulevard; Thence proceed in a northerly
7 direction across Bob Pettit Boulevard to the southeast corner of Lot 60
8 Tigerland Acres Subdivision, said point being located on the north right of way
9 line of Bob Pettit Boulevard; Thence proceed in a northerly direction along the
10 east line of Lot 60 Tigerland Acres Subdivision to the northeast corner of said
11 Lot 60 Tigerland Acres Subdivision; Thence proceed in a southwesterly
12 direction along the north line Tigerland Acres Subdivision to the northwest
13 corner of said Tigerland Acres Subdivision, said point being the northeast
14 corner of the called 100 Ac tract, said tract comprising the Louisiana School for
15 the Deaf; Thence proceed in a southwesterly then southerly direction along the
16 north and west perimeter of the called 100 Ac tract, said tract comprising the
17 Louisiana School for the Deaf to a point on the north line of the existing City of
18 Baton Rouge Fire station No. 15; Thence proceed in a northwesterly then
19 southwesterly direction along the perimeter of the property line of the existing
20 City of Baton Rouge Fire station No. 15 to a point on the north right of way line
21 of Brightside Drive; Thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the
22 north right of way line of Brightside Drive and its westward extension thereof
23 to the East Baton Rouge Parish Line located in the Mississippi River; Thence
24 proceed in a northerly direction along the East Baton Rouge Parish Line to the
25 point of beginning.

26 (b) The following areas shall be excluded from the district:

27 Commence at a point which is the northwest corner of Lot 8-A, Square
28 E, Arbour Place Subdivision, which point is located on the south right of way
29 line of East State Street; Thence proceed in a northeasterly direction along the

1 south right of way line of East State Street to the northeast corner of Lot 3, Sq.
2 4, Louisiana Terrace Subdivision, said point is also on the property line of the
3 LSU campus property; Thence proceed in a southerly direction along the east
4 line of Louisiana Terrace Subdivision to the southeast corner of Lot 10 Sq. 4,
5 Louisiana Terrace Subdivision; Thence proceed in a westerly direction along
6 the south line of Lot 10 Sq. 4, Louisiana Terrace Subdivision to its intersection
7 with the east right of way line of Carlotta Street; Thence proceed in a southerly
8 direction along the east right of way line of Carlotta Street to the north line of
9 the LSU Campus Property; Thence proceed in a westerly direction along the
10 north line of the LSU campus property to a point having Louisiana State Plane
11 South Zone coordinates of X:3331241, Y:697168; Thence proceed in a southerly
12 direction through the LSU campus property S 02° 22' E a distance of 165 feet
13 more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a westerly direction through the LSU
14 campus property S 87° 41' W a distance of 152 feet more or less to a point;
15 Thence proceed in a southerly direction through the LSU campus property S
16 02° 02' E a distance of 154 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in an
17 easterly direction through the LSU campus property N 77° 36' E a distance of
18 139 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a northerly direction
19 through the LSU campus property N 01° 51' W a distance of 110 feet more or
20 less to a point; Thence proceed in an easterly direction through the LSU campus
21 property N 88° 48' E a distance of 165 feet more or less to a point; Thence
22 proceed in a southerly direction through the LSU campus property S 01° 40' E
23 a distance of 311 feet more or less to a point located 30 feet north of the
24 centerline of Dalrymple Drive; Thence proceed in a westerly direction on a line
25 parallel to and 30 feet north of the centerline of Dalrymple Drive to a point on
26 the westerly line of the area commonly known as Fraternity Row, said point
27 having Louisiana State Plane South Zone coordinates of X:3330524, Y:696768;
28 Thence proceed in a northerly direction through the LSU campus property N
29 00° 02' E a distance of 106 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a

1 northeasterly direction through the LSU campus property N 25° 24' E a
2 distance of 96 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in an easterly
3 direction through the LSU campus property N 87° 52' E a distance of 122 feet
4 more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a northerly direction through the
5 LSU campus property N 02° 33' W a distance of 108 feet more or less to a point;
6 Thence proceed in a westerly direction through the LSU campus property S 87°
7 51' W a distance of 144 feet more or less to a point; Thence proceed in a
8 northerly direction through the LSU campus property N 01° 56' W a distance
9 of 148 feet more or less to a point located on the south right of way line of East

2 (c) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the property
3 descriptions provided in Subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this Paragraph, whether
4 specifically identified or not, no portion of the LSU EDD shall include any tract
5 of land that is used for residential purposes, except for hotels, motels, inns
6 and/or bed and breakfasts for temporary occupancy, in any form or fashion,
7 including, without limitation, private and/or public homes, residences, housing,
8 dwellings, apartments, studios, flats, townhomes, condominiums, cooperatives,
9 residential rooms, residential beds, dormitories, student residences and housing,
10 student apartments, fraternity houses, sorority houses, student residential
11 quarters and/or other form or housing, as of the effective date of this Act,
12 individually and collectively "Residential Properties". All Residential
13 Properties are deemed District Exclusions. In the event that the description of
14 the LSU EDD set forth above includes any of the District Exclusions, such
15 District Exclusion shall not be considered as a component of the LSU EDD.

16 (2)(a) The Southern University Economic Development District ("SU
17 EDD") encompasses an area within the Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana
18 generally bounded to the north by the northern line of Township 6 South,
19 Range 1 West, Greensburg Land District, Louisiana and Baton Rouge Barge
20 Canal Road, to the south by Choctaw Drive, to the west by the Mississippi
21 River, and to the east by Scenic Highway, and Kansas City Southern Rail
22 subject to, and less and except, the exclusions as defined below ("District
23 Exclusions"), and being more fully described as follows:

24 Commence at the point of intersection of the northern line of Township

1 NWWTP, across Avenue M and to the intersection of the west right-of-way of
2 Avenue L; thence southerly along the west right-of-way of Avenue L being
3 common with the boundary of Tract NWWTP to the intersection of the south
4 right-of-way of Woodpecker Street; thence easterly along the south right-of-way
5 of Woodpecker Street being common with the boundary of Tract NWWTP to
6 the intersection of the west right-of-way of Avenue K; thence southerly along
7 the west right-of-way of Avenue K being common with the boundary of Tract
8 NWWTP to the intersection of the south right-of-way of Mills Avenue being the
9 northern boundary of Southern University; thence easterly along the south
10 right-of-way of Mills Avenue and across Kansas City Southern Rail to the
11 intersection of the east right-of-way of Kansas City Southern Rail; thence
12 southeasterly along said right-of-way of Kansas City Southern Rail to the
13 intersection of the north right-of-way of W.K. Gordon Street; thence
14 northeasterly along said right-of-way of W.K. Gordon Street and across Scenic
15 Highway to the intersection of the east right-of-way of Scenic Highway; thence
16 northwesterly along said right-of-way of Scenic Highway to the intersection of
17 the south right-of-way of Rosenwald Road; thence easterly along said right-of-
18 way of Rosenwald Road being common with the north boundary of Lot 94-X of
19 North Baton Rouge subdivision to the northeast corner of said Lot 94-X; thence
20 turning approximately 90 degrees to the right and continue southerly along the
21 east boundary of Lots 94-X, 94-Y and 94 of North Baton Rouge subdivision to
22 the southeast corner of said Lot 94; thence turning approximately 90 degrees
23 to the right and continue westerly along the south boundary of said Lot 94 to the
24 intersection of the east right-of-way of Scenic Highway; thence southeasterly
25 along said right-of-way of Scenic Highway approximately 267 feet to a point;
26 thence turning approximately 86 degrees to the right and continue

28 (c) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the property
29 descriptions provided in Subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this Paragraph, whether

1 specifically identified or not, no portion of the SU EDD shall include any tract
2 of land that is used for residential purposes, except for hotels, motels, inns
3 and/or bed and breakfasts for temporary occupancy, in any form or fashion,
4 including, without limitation, private and/or public homes, residences, housing,
5 dwellings, apartments, studios, flats, townhomes, condominiums, cooperatives,
6 residential rooms, residential beds, dormitories, student residences and housing,
7 student apartments, fraternity houses, sorority houses, student residential
8 quarters and/or other form or housing, as of the effective date of this Act,
9 individually and collectively "Residential Properties". All Residential
10 Properties are deemed District Exclusions. In the event that the description of
11 the SU EDD set forth above includes any of the District Exclusions, such District
12 Exclusions shall not be considered as a component of the SU EDD.

13 C.(1) A college economic development district shall be administered and
14 governed by a board of commissioners, referred to in this Section as the
15 "board".

16 (2) The board shall be comprised as follows:

17 (a) The highest executive officer of the college shall appoint four persons
18 and shall serve as a member of the board and chairman of the board as long as
19 he is the highest executive officer of the University.

20 (b) Two of the members of the board shall be representatives from
21 businesses within the district.

22 (3) Members shall serve five-year terms after initial terms as provided
23 by the ordinance creating the district. The president shall serve as long as he is
24 president of the university. Two members shall serve an initial term of two
25 years, and two members shall serve an initial term of three years, as determined
26 by lot at the first meeting of the board. Each member of the board shall
27 continue to serve until reappointed or a successor is duly appointed. Any
28 vacancy in the membership of the board shall be filled in the manner of the
29 original appointment for the unexpired term. If an appointment to fill a vacancy

1 is not made within sixty days, the board shall appoint an interim successor to
2 serve until the position is filled by the appointing authority.

3 (4) Any member of the board may be removed by a three-fourths vote
4 of the remaining membership of the board for cause, which cause may include
5 failure to attend at least one-half of the meetings of the board in a two-year
6 period.

7 (5) The members of the board shall serve without salary or per diem.
8 The board may reimburse any member for reasonable, actual, and necessary
9 expenses incurred in the performance of his duties pursuant to this Section.

10 (6) The board shall elect from its members a president, a vice president,
11 a secretary, and a treasurer, whose duties shall be those common to such offices.
12 At the option of the board, the offices of secretary and treasurer may be held by
13 one person.

14 (7) The board shall meet in regular session at least once a year and shall
15 also meet in special session as often as the president of the board convenes the
16 board or upon the written request of at least three members. A majority of the
17 members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
18 The board shall keep minutes of all meetings and shall make them available for
19 inspection through the board's secretary or secretary-treasurer, who shall also
20 maintain the minute books and archives of the district. The monies, funds, and
21 accounts of the district shall be in the official custody of the board.

22 (8) The domicile of the board shall be established by the board at a
23 location within the district. The official journal of the district is the official
24 journal of the parish where the domicile of the board is located.

25 D. A college economic development district, acting by and through its
26 board, shall have and exercise all powers of a political subdivision necessary or
27 convenient for the carrying out of its objects and purposes, including but not
28 limited to the following:

29 (1) To sue and to be sued.

1 (2) To adopt, use, and alter at will a corporate seal.

2 (3) To acquire by gift, grant, or purchase all property, including rights-
3 of-way, movable, immovable, or mixed, corporeal or incorporeal, or any interest
4 therein.

5 (4) To enter into contracts for the purchase, acquisition, construction,
6 and improvement of works and facilities necessary in connection with the
7 purposes of the district.

8 (5) In its own name and on its own behalf to incur debt and to issue
9 revenue bonds, special assessment bonds, certificates, notes, and other evidences
10 of indebtedness and to levy and cause to be collected certain taxes as provided
11 in this Section and as may be provided by general law.

12 (6) To regulate the imposition of fees and rentals charged by the district
13 for its facilities and services rendered by it.

14 (7) To borrow money and pledge all or part of its revenues, leases, rents,
15 or other advantages as security for such loans.

16 (8) To appoint officers, agents, and employees, prescribe their duties, and
17 fix their compensation.

18 (9) To develop public improvement projects for the benefit of the
19 respective college, either directly with the respective college or through one or
20 more private foundations or nonprofit corporations affiliated with the
21 respective college, or both.

22 (10) To exercise any and all of the powers granted to an economic
23 development district as if the district were an economic development district
24 established pursuant to Part II of this Chapter, including but not limited to the
25 powers of tax increment financing pursuant to R.S. 33:9038.33 and 33:9038.34
26 and the power to levy taxes within the district pursuant to R.S. 33:9038.39. The
27 district shall exercise such powers in accordance with the provisions of Part II
28 of this Chapter.

29 (11) To exercise any and all of the powers granted to a community

1 development district as if the district were a community development district
2 established pursuant to Chapter 27-B of this Title, including but not limited to
3 the power to levy special assessments on property within the district pursuant
4 to R.S. 33:9039.29. The district shall exercise such powers in accordance with
5 the provisions of Chapter 27-B of this Title.

6 E.(1) It is expressly provided that any sales and use tax levied by a
7 college economic development district or any subdistrict created by the district
8 may exceed the limitation set forth by Article VI, Section 29(A) of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana and shall be imposed, collected, and enforced subject
10 to the terms of the resolution imposing the tax and the provisions of Chapter 2
11 of Subtitle II of Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

12 (2)(a) A college economic development district and any subdistrict
13 created by the district may levy taxes or assessments of any type only after the
14 board has adopted an appropriate resolution giving notice of its intention to
15 levy such taxes or assessments. The resolution shall include a general
16 description of the taxes or assessments to be levied. The district or subdistrict
17 shall give notice of its intention by publication once a week for two weeks in the
18 official journal of the district, the first publication to appear at least fourteen
19 days before the public meeting of the board at which the board shall hear any
20 objections to the proposed taxes or assessments. The notice of intent so
21 published shall state the date, time, and place of the public hearing.

22 (b) Such taxes or assessments may be levied only after the board has
23 called a special election submitting the proposition for the levy of such taxes or
24 assessments to the qualified electors of the district or subdistrict, as applicable,
25 and the proposition has received the favorable vote of a majority of the electors
26 voting in the election. However, if there are no qualified electors in the district
27 or subdistrict, as applicable, as certified by the registrar of voters, no such
28 election is required, but the taxes or assessments shall not be levied unless
29 approved by the governing authority of the local governmental subdivision.

1 (c) The powers and rights conferred by this Paragraph shall be in
2 addition to the powers and rights conferred by any other general or special law.
3 This Paragraph does and shall be construed to provide a complete and
4 additional method for the levy of any taxes or assessments. No election,
5 proceeding, notice, or approval shall be required for the levy of such taxes or
6 assessments except as provided in this Paragraph.

7 F.(1) A college economic development district may create subdistricts as
8 provided in this Subsection. The district shall publish notice of its intent to
9 create a subdistrict in the official journal of the district. At least ten days after
10 publication of such notice, the board shall conduct a public hearing on the
11 question of creating the subdistrict. Thereafter, the board may designate one or
12 more areas within the boundaries of the district as subdistricts of the district.
13 Each subdistrict shall constitute a political subdivision of the state and shall be
14 governed by the board. Each subdistrict shall have the same powers as the
15 district and shall be given a suitable name as the board may designate.
16 Hereafter in this Section, any reference to the district includes any subdistrict
17 created by the district.

18 (2) The boundaries of a district may be changed in accordance with
19 provisions of this Section dealing with the establishment of the original
20 boundaries. If a district is expanded to include an area where qualified electors
21 reside, no tax shall be collected in the added area unless the qualified electors
22 of that added area approve the tax in accordance with Subparagraph (E)(2)(b)
23 of this Section.

24 G.(1) The district may issue and sell from time to time bonds, notes,
25 renewal notes, refunding bonds, interim certificates, certificates of indebtedness,
26 certificates of participation, debentures, warrants, commercial paper, or other
27 obligations or evidences of indebtedness to provide funds for and to fulfill and
28 achieve its public purpose or corporate purposes, as set forth in this Section,
29 including but not limited to the payment of all or a portion of the costs of a

1 project, to provide amounts necessary for any corporate purposes, including
2 necessary and incidental expenses in connection with the issuance of the
3 obligations, the payment of principal and interest on the obligations of the
4 district, the establishment of reserves to secure such obligations, and all other
5 purposes and expenditures of the district incident to and necessary or
6 convenient to carry out its public functions or corporate purposes, and any
7 credit enhancement for said obligations.

8 (2) Except as may otherwise be provided by the board, all obligations
9 issued by the district shall be negotiable instruments and payable solely from
10 the revenues of the district as determined by the board, or from any other
11 source that may be available to the district but shall not be secured by the full
12 faith and credit of the state or the local governmental subdivision.

13 (3) Obligations shall be authorized, issued, and sold by a resolution or
14 resolutions of the board. Such bonds or obligations may be of such series, bear
15 such date or dates, mature at such time or times, bear interest at such rate or
16 rates, including variable, adjustable, or zero interest rates, be payable at such
17 time or times, be in such denominations, be sold at such price or prices, at
18 public or private negotiated sale, after advertisement as is provided for in R.S.
19 39:1426, be in such form, carry such registration and exchangeability privileges,
20 be payable at such place or places, be subject to such terms of redemption, and
21 be entitled to such priorities on the income, revenue, and receipts of, or
22 available to, the district as may be provided by the board in the resolution or
23 resolutions providing for the issuance and sale of the bonds or obligations of the
24 district.

25 (4) The obligations of the district shall be signed by such officers of the
26 board by either manual or facsimile signatures as shall be determined by
27 resolution or resolutions of the board and may have impressed or imprinted
28 thereon the seal of the district or a facsimile thereof.

29 (5) Any obligations of the district may be validly issued, sold, and

1 delivered, notwithstanding that one or more of the officers of the board signing
2 such obligations, or whose facsimile signature or signatures may be on the
3 obligations, shall have ceased to be such officer of the board at the time such
4 obligations shall actually have been delivered.

5 (6) Obligations of the district may be sold in such manner and from time
6 to time as may be determined by the board to be most beneficial, subject to
7 approval of the State Bond Commission, and the district may pay all expenses,
8 premiums, fees, or commissions which it may deem necessary or advantageous
9 in connection with the issuance and sale thereof.

10 (7) The board may authorize the establishment of a fund or funds for the
11 creation of a debt service reserve, a renewal and replacement reserve, or such
12 other funds or reserves as the board may approve with respect to the financing
13 and operation of any project funded with the proceeds of such bonds and as
14 may be authorized by any bond resolution, trust agreement, indenture of trust
15 or similar instrument or agreement pursuant to the provisions of which the
16 issuance of bonds or other obligations of the district or subdistrict may be
17 authorized.

18 (8) Any cost, obligation, or expense incurred for any of the purposes or
19 powers of the district specified in this Subsection shall be a part of the project
20 costs and may be paid or reimbursed as such out of the proceeds of bonds or
21 other obligations issued by the district; however, no portion of any state sales
22 taxes made directly available to the district pursuant to an agreement with the
23 state shall be used by the district to pay the costs of constructing or operating
24 any privately owned hotel located within the district, without the consent of the
25 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget or its successor.

26 (9) For a period of thirty days from the date of publication of the
27 resolution authorizing the issuance of bonds hereunder, any persons in interest
28 shall have the right to contest the legality of the resolution and the legality of the
29 bond issue for any cause, after which time no one shall have any cause or right

1 of action to contest the legality of the resolution or of the bonds authorized
2 thereby for any cause whatsoever. If no suit, action, or proceeding is begun
3 contesting the validity of the bond issue within thirty days, the authority to issue
4 the bonds and to provide for the payment thereof, and the legality thereof and
5 all of the provisions of the resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds shall
6 be conclusively presumed, and no court shall have authority to inquire into such
7 matters.

8 (10) Neither the members of the board nor any person executing the
9 bonds shall be personally liable for the bonds or be subject to any personal
10 liability by reason of the issuance thereof. No earnings or assets of the district
11 shall accrue to the benefit of any private persons. However, the limitation of
12 liability provided for in this Paragraph shall not apply to any gross negligence
13 or criminal negligence on the part of any member of the board or person
14 executing the bonds.

15 (11) All obligations authorized to be issued by the district pursuant to the
16 provisions of this Subsection, together with interest thereof, income therefrom,
17 and gain upon the sale thereof shall be exempt from all state and local taxes.

18 (12) The state and all public officers, any parish, municipality, or other
19 subdivision or instrumentality of the state, any political subdivision, any bank,
20 banker, trust company, savings bank and institution, building and loan
21 association, savings and loan association, investment company or any person
22 carrying on a banking or investment business, any insurance company or
23 business, insurance association, and any person carrying on an insurance
24 business, and any executor, administrator, curator, trustee, and other fiduciary,
25 and any retirement system or pension fund may legally invest any sinking funds
26 monies, or other funds belonging to them or within their control in any bonds
27 or other obligations issued by the district pursuant to the provisions of this
28 Subsection, and such bonds or other obligations shall be authorized security for
29 all public deposits. It is the purpose of this Section to authorize such persons,

1 firms, corporations, associations, political subdivisions and officers, or other
2 entities, public or private, to use any funds owned or controlled by them,
3 including but not limited to sinking, insurance, investment, retirement,
4 compensation, pension and trust funds, and funds held on deposit, for the
5 purchase of any such bonds or other obligations of the district or subdistrict,
6 and that any such bonds shall be authorized security for all public deposits.
7 However, nothing contained in this Section with regard to legal investments or
8 security for public deposits shall be construed as relieving any such person,
9 firm, corporation, or other entity from any duty of exercising reasonable care
10 in selecting securities.

11 H. Notwithstanding anything in this Section, each college economic
12 development district and any subdistrict created by such college district, and
13 the governing board of commissioners for such district and subdistrict shall not
14 have any power, authority or right to levy taxes, assessment or fees of any type
15 or form on any property in any area within such district or subdistrict that is
16 used or operated now or in the future for any industrial use, "industrial
17 properties", as defined below.

18 (1) Each college economic development district and any subdistrict
19 created by such college district may be the recipient of a sales or use tax
20 increment which consist of that portion of the designated incremental sales or
21 use tax collected each year on the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the
22 consumption and storage for use or consumption of tangible personal property,
23 and on sales of services, all as defined in R.S. 47:301 et seq., or any other
24 appropriate provision or provisions of law as amended.

25 (2) The sales or use tax increment may include hotel occupancy taxes,
26 occupancy taxes, or similar taxes, or any combination of such taxes, levied upon
27 the use or occupancy of hotel rooms if so designated by the city of Baton Rouge,
28 parish of East Baton Rouge as the tax recipient entity, from taxpayers located
29 within a college economic development district and subdistrict which exceeds

1 the designated sales or use tax revenues and hotel occupancy taxes, occupancy
2 taxes, or similar taxes so designated that were collected in the year immediately
3 prior to the year in which the college economic development district and any
4 subdistrict was established. For purposes of this Subsection "industrial uses"
5 means the activities within land areas predominantly used, in whole or in part,
6 connected with industrial, manufacturing, fabricating, constructing, assembly,
7 processing, treating, storage and/or wholesale distribution of products,
8 commodity, goods, materials and/or articles, including, for illustration, but
9 without limitation:

10 (a) The processing of raw materials or substances.

11 (b) The making, manufacturing or assembling of semi-finished or
12 finished goods, products or equipment.

13 (c) The cleaning, servicing, repairing or testing of materials, goods and
14 equipment normally associated with industrial businesses or cleaning, servicing
15 and repair operations to goods and equipment use, where such operations have
16 impacts that would make them incompatible in non-industrial property or
17 areas.

18 (d) The storage or transshipping of materials, products, goods and
19 equipment.

20 (e) The distribution and sale of materials, products, goods and
21 equipment to institutions or industrial and commercial businesses for their
22 direct use or to stores for resale to individual customers.

23 (f) The training of personnel in general industrial operations.

24 (g) Any other permitted uses on Industrial Properties set forth in the
25 Unified Development Code for the City of Baton Rouge / Parish of East Baton
26 Rouge, Louisiana ("UDC") in Section 8.211 (M1 Light Industrial District and
27 Section 8.212 (M 2 Heavy Industrial District) as each may be amended
28 (individually and collectively "Industrial District Zoning").

29 I. A college economic development district shall dissolve and cease to

1 exist upon the later to occur of either one year after the date on which all loans,
 2 bonds, notes, and other evidences of indebtedness of the district, including
 3 refunding bonds, are paid in full as to both principal and interest, or fifty years
 4 from the creation of the district.

5 J. This Section, being necessary for the welfare of the state, the parish,
 6 and its residents, shall be liberally construed to effect the purposes thereof.

7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
 11 effective on the day following such approval.

Fields

Proposed law provides for the creation of an economic development district that includes property owned by SU and LSU. The purpose of such a district is to provide for cooperative economic and community development among the district, the colleges, the parish or municipal governing authority, the state, and the owners of property in the district. The parish or municipal governing authority shall establish the boundaries of a district in the ordinance creating it; such boundaries may be changed and are not required to be contiguous.

Proposed law provides that such a district is governed by a board of commissioners, comprised as follows:

- (1) The highest executive officer of the college.
- (2) Four persons appointed by the highest executive officer of the college.

Proposed law provides that two of the members of the board shall be representatives from business within the district.

Proposed law provides that commissioners serve five-year terms, with vacancies filled in the manner of the original appointment. Provides that the president shall serve as long as he is president of the university. Two members shall serve an initial term of two years, and two members shall serve an initial term of three years, as determined by lot at the first meeting of the board. However, if an appointment to fill a vacancy is not made within 60 days, the board shall appoint an interim successor to serve until the position is filled by the appointing authority. Authorizes removal of a commissioner for cause by a 3/4 vote of the board. Provides that commissioners serve without compensation but authorizes reimbursement of expenses.

Proposed law provides that the official journal of such a district is the official journal of the

parish where the domicile of the board is located. Provides that a district created pursuant to proposed law is a political subdivision of the state and has the powers of a political subdivision. Provides that such powers include the power:

- (1) To develop public improvement projects for the benefit of the respective college, either directly with the respective college or through one or more private foundations or nonprofit corporations affiliated with the respective college, or both.
- (2) To exercise the powers granted to an economic development district established pursuant to present law. (Present law authorizes such a district to utilize tax increment financing. Further authorizes a district to levy ad valorem taxes up to five mills, sales taxes up to 2%, and hotel occupancy taxes up to 2%, all subject to voter approval unless there are no voters in the district.)
- (3) To exercise the powers granted to a community development district established pursuant present law. (Present law authorizes such a district to finance, construct, and operate various public facilities and authorizes the levy of special property assessments, based on proportionate benefit from the facility, to fund such activities.)

Proposed law provides procedures for the levy of any tax or assessment, including a requirement for voter approval unless there are no voters in the district. If a district is expanded to include an area where qualified electors reside, proposed law prohibits collection of a tax in the added area unless the qualified electors of that added area approve the tax.

Proposed law authorizes such a district to create subdistricts which are governed by the board of commissioners and have the same powers as the district.

Proposed law provides that each college economic development district and any subdistrict created by such college district, and the governing board of commissioners for such district and subdistrict shall not have any power, authority or right to levy taxes, assessment or fees of any type or form on any property in any area within such district or subdistrict that is used or operated now or in the future for any industrial use, "industrial properties", as defined below.

Proposed law provides that each college economic development district and any subdistrict created by such college district may be the recipient of a sales or use tax increment which consist of that portion of the designated incremental sales or use tax collected each year on the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption and storage for use or consumption of tangible personal property, and on sales of services.

Proposed law provides that the sales or use tax increment may include hotel occupancy taxes, occupancy taxes, or similar taxes, or any combination of such taxes, levied upon the use or occupancy of hotel rooms if so designated by the city of Baton Rouge, parish of East Baton Rouge as the tax recipient entity, from taxpayers located within a college economic development district and subdistrict which exceeds the designated sales or use tax revenues and hotel occupancy taxes, occupancy taxes, or similar taxes so designated that were collected in the year immediately prior to the year in which the college economic development district and any subdistrict was established.

Proposed law authorizes the district to issue bonds and to otherwise incur debt. Provides requirements and procedures therefor.

Proposed law provides that such a district shall dissolve and cease to exist upon the later to occur of either one year after the date on which all debt of the district is paid in full or 50 years from the creation of the district.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs to the original bill

1. Removes that authority of a local governing authority to create the districts and instead creates the districts legislatively.
2. Changes the boundaries of the cooperative economic districts.
3. Changes the board of commissioners of the cooperative economic districts.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Makes changes to the boundaries of the Southern University Economic Development District.
2. Removes the requirement that one of the board members for the Southern University Economic Development District be a business representative from the largest commercial landowner within the district.
3. Prohibits any new taxes on business classified as industrial in the districts.
4. Provides that each college economic development district and any subdistrict created by such college district may be the recipient of a sales or use tax increment.
