Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

1. Delete proposed law adding two additional consumer members.
2. Provide for the consumer member to be a representative of minority consumers.
3. Delete proposed law relative to licensure reciprocity.
4. Require certain continuing education hours be obtained in-person.
5. Prohibit a licensee from obtaining more than six hours of continuing education online.
6. Provide for permissible sources of continuing education.
7. Make technical changes.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Change the permissible sources of continuing education.
