#### **GREEN SHEET REDIGEST**

HB 291 2023 Regular Session Charles Owen

HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES. Provides for visitation policies at certain healthcare facilities and requires that such policies allow for in-person visitation.

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#### **DIGEST**

Proposed law shall be known and may be cited as the "No Patient Left Alone Law".

Proposed law applies to all of the following facilities:

- (1) Licensed centers that provide care for persons with developmental disabilities as defined in <u>present law</u>.
- (2) Hospitals as defined in present law.
- (3) Licensed facilities that provide inpatient hospice care as defined in present law.
- (4) Nursing homes as defined in present law.

Proposed law provides for legislative findings.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that visitation policies and procedures may not require visitors to submit proof of any vaccination or immunization.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that visitation policies shall allow consensual nonsexual physical contact such as hand holding or hugging.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a facility to submit a written copy of its visitation policies and procedures to the Health Standards Section of the La. Dept. of Health (LDH) at the initial licensure survey. <u>Proposed law</u> further requires visitation policies and procedures to be made available for review by LDH at any time, upon request.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a facility to make its policies and procedures easily accessible from the homepage of its website no later than 24 hours after establishing the policies and procedures required by <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires LDH to dedicate a stand-alone page on its website to explain the visitation requirements set forth in <u>proposed law</u> and provide a link to the department's webpage to report complaints.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Insert language to specify that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> apply to licensed facilities that provide inpatient hospice care.
- 2. Require facilities to submit a written copy of visitation policies and procedures to the Health Standards Section of the Louisiana Department of Health at the initial licensure survey.

- 3. Require the La. Dept. of Health to dedicate a stand-alone page on its website to explain the visitation requirements of <u>proposed law</u> and provide a link to the department's webpage to report complaints.
- 4. Make technical corrections.

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

# Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the engrossed bill

- 1. Provide for legislative findings.
- 2. Remove <u>proposed law</u> requiring facilities to establish visitation polices.
- 3. Remove <u>proposed law providing</u> for the designation of an essential caregiver.
- 4. Add references to <u>present law</u> providing for in-person visitation rights.
- 5. Provide for visitation policies to include the right to consensual nonsexual physical contact such as hand holding or hugging.
- 6. Provide for visitation policies to not require visitors to submit proof of any vaccination or immunization.
- 7. Make technical changes.
