Proposed law further indicates applicants that give consent will allow their genetic information to be obtained and stored in a national database and accessible by cancer doctors.

Effective July 1, 2024.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the original bill

1. Provides for bone marrow donation and the process in which the office of motor vehicles must obtain consent for donation.
2. Removes bone marrow from the organ donor section of law.
3. Provides for the process of bone marrow donation and match with patients.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Provides the proper name for the National Marrow Donor Program.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the reengrossed bill:

1. Add a special effective date of July 1, 2024.
