2	To urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to provide optional
3	identification tags to inmates assigned to work in state buildings, which shall be
4	provided at no cost to the inmates.
5	WHEREAS, inmate identification helps build safety, security, and compliance; and
6	WHEREAS, the use of optional identification tags for inmates assigned to work in
7	state buildings allows for inmates to be identified by their name; and
8	WHEREAS, identifying inmates assigned to work in state buildings by name could
9	help increase morale and instill dignity and humanity in the workplace.
10	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
11	urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to provide optional
12	identification tags to inmates assigned to work in state buildings, which shall be provided
13	at no cost to the inmates.
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
15	secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.
