Present law provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the potential for addiction and abuse of the substances.

Proposed law adds Zipeprol, Amineptine, Mesocarb, and Methiopropamine to Schedule I.

Proposed law adds Daridorexant to Schedule IV and removes Fenfluramine.

Proposed law adds Ganaxolone to Schedule V.

Proposed law updates the structural language for stimulants and synthetic cannabinoids in Schedule I.

Present law provides relative to the crime of unlawful production, manufacture, distribution, or possession of hallucinogenic plants. Further provides for a list of parts or portions of "hallucinogenic plants".

Proposed law adds "amanita pantherina" to hallucinogenic plants.

Effective August 1, 2023.

(Amends R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(E)(1)(i) and (iii) and (8) and (F)(1)-(8), (12), (17)-(22), and (24)-(29) and (Schedule V)(D)(6); Adds R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(100) and (E)(14)-(16), (Schedule IV)(B)(58), and (Schedule V)(D)(7), and 989.1(C)(2)(nn); Repeals R.S. 40:964(Schedule IV)(C))

2. Make technical changes.
