5 On page 1, line 2, change "R.S. 42:17.2 and 17.3," to "R.S. 42:17.2,"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

19 **"E. (1) Each public body that has the capability to allow any member of**
20 **the public with a disability recognized by the Americans with Disabilities Act**
21 **or a designated caregiver of such a person to participate in its meetings via**
22 **teleconference or video conference as defined in R.S. 42:17.2 shall adopt rules,**
23 **regulations, and procedures to regulate and facilitate participation via**
24 **teleconference or video conference for any such person who prior to the**
25 **meeting requests that accommodation.**

26 **(2) Each public body that does not have the capability to allow any**
27 **member of the public with a disability recognized by the Americans with**
28 **Disabilities Act or a designated caregiver of such a person to participate in its**
29 **meetings via teleconference or video conference as defined in R.S. 42:17.2 shall**
30 **adopt rules, regulations, and procedures to facilitate viable alternative methods**
31 **for a member of the public with a disability recognized by the Americans with**
32 **Disabilities Act or a designated caregiver of such a person who so requests to**
33 **participate in its meetings.**

34 **(3) The requirements of this Subsection shall not be applicable during**
35 **an executive session held in accordance with law, during any meeting that is**
36 **sequestered in accordance with law, or any meeting of a parish board of election**

1 supervisors when performing duties pursuant to R.S. 18:573, 574, 1309.1, 1313,
 2 or 1313.1.

4 §17.2 Exception for certain meetings of the ~~pharmacy benefit manager monitoring~~
 5 ~~advisory council~~ certain public bodies

6 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter to the contrary, the
 7 ~~pharmacy benefit manager monitoring advisory council, as provided for in R.S.~~
 8 ~~40:2869, a public body identified in Subsection H of this Section~~ may conduct and
 9 its members may attend and participate in a meeting via electronic means provided
 10 that ~~the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy, the Department of Insurance, and the advisory~~
 11 ~~council and its presiding officer comply with all of the requirements of this Section~~
 12 ~~are met.~~

13 B. No later than twenty-four hours prior to a meeting conducted pursuant to
 14 the provisions of this Section, the ~~Louisiana Board of Pharmacy, the Department of~~
 15 ~~Insurance, and the advisory council~~ public body shall provide for all of the
 16 following:

17 (1) The notice and agenda for the meeting, which shall be posted on the
 18 website of the ~~Louisiana Board of Pharmacy and the Department of Insurance~~ public
 19 body, emailed to any member of the public or the news media who requests notice
 20 of meetings of the public body, and widely posted and distributed to ~~every known~~
 21 ~~news media outlet that broadcasts or publishes news within the geographic area~~
 22 ~~within the jurisdiction of the public body~~ as otherwise required by this Chapter
 23 and by law.

24 (2) Detailed information regarding how members of the public may
 25 participate in the meeting and submit comments regarding matters on the agenda,
 26 which information shall be posted on the website of the ~~Louisiana Board of~~
 27 ~~Pharmacy and the Department of Insurance,~~ public body and emailed to any
 28 member of the public or the news media who requests notice of meetings of ~~the~~
 29 ~~public body, and widely distributed to every known news media outlet that~~
 30 ~~broadcasts or publishes news within the geographic area within the jurisdiction of the~~
 31 ~~public body.~~

32 C. For each meeting conducted pursuant to this Section, the following
 33 requirements shall apply:

34 (1) The presiding officer shall be present and shall preside over the
 35 meeting at the anchor location. The anchor location shall be open to the public.
 36 Any member of the public body or the public shall be allowed to participate in-
 37 person at the anchor location.

38 (2) The ~~advisory council~~ public body shall provide a mechanism to receive
 39 public comment electronically in the manner it prescribes both prior to and, to the
 40 extent practical, during the meeting.

41 (2) (3) The ~~advisory council~~ public body shall ~~properly identify and~~
 42 ~~acknowledge all public comments during the meeting and shall maintain those~~
 43 ~~comments in its record of the meeting.~~

44 (3)(4) The presiding officer of the ~~advisory council~~ public body shall ensure
 45 ~~both~~ all of the following:

46 (a) That each person participating in the meeting is properly identified.

47 (b) That all parts of the meeting, excluding any matter discussed in executive
 48 session, are clear and audible to all participants in the meeting including the public.

49 (c) That the voting decision of each participating member of the public
 50 body on each matter is clearly identified during each vote during the meeting
 51 and recorded and included in the archive of the meeting.

52 (5) If the public body is aware of a technical problem that causes the
 53 meeting to no longer be audible. or if applicable, visible and audible to the
 54 public, the meeting shall be recessed until the problem is resolved. If the
 55 problem is not resolved within one hour, the meeting shall be adjourned and the
 56 presiding officer shall make an effort to alert all participants to that fact.

1 (6) The meeting shall be recorded and made available to the public in
 2 an online archive located on the public body's website for at least two years.

3 D. For the purposes of this Section, the following definitions apply:

4 (1) "Anchor location" means the physical location from which the
 5 meeting via electronic means originates or the participants are connected.

6 (2) "Meeting via electronic means" shall mean a meeting occurring at which
 7 one or more members of a public body or members of the public participate via
 8 teleconference or video conference.

9 ~~(2)~~(3) "Teleconference" shall mean a method of communication which
 10 enables persons in different locations to participate in a meeting and to hear and
 11 otherwise communicate with each other.

12 ~~(3)~~(4) "Video conference" shall mean a method of communication which
 13 enables persons in different locations to participate in a meeting and to see, hear, and
 14 otherwise communicate with each other.

15 E.(1) All members of the public body participating in a meeting held
 16 pursuant to this Section, either at the anchor location or via electronic means,
 17 shall be counted for the purpose of establishing a quorum and may vote.

18 (2) Each public body conducting meetings pursuant to this Section shall
 19 adopt rules, regulations, and procedures to allow the public to participate in the
 20 meeting via electronic means.

21 F.(1) Under no circumstances shall a public body conduct all of its
 22 meetings during a calendar year via electronic means pursuant to this Section.
 23 Except as otherwise provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, each public
 24 body that conducts meetings via electronic means pursuant to this Section shall
 25 limit the number of successive meetings via electronic means to a reasonable
 26 number and shall, to the extent practicable, publish a schedule of its meetings
 27 indicating which upcoming meetings will be conducted via electronic means and
 28 which will be conducted only in person.

29 (2) Any public body that is strictly advisory or that primarily focuses on
 30 issues dealing with disabilities or assisting military families may conduct
 31 successive meetings via electronic means without limitation and shall, to the
 32 extent practicable, publish a schedule of its meetings indicating which upcoming
 33 meetings will be conducted via electronic means and which will be conducted
 34 only in person.

35 G. No member of a public body who participates in a meeting via
 36 electronic means shall be eligible to or receive per diem for attendance at the
 37 meeting.

38 H.(1) Except as provided in Subsection I of this Section, the provisions
 39 of this Section shall apply to any public body which has powers, duties, or
 40 functions that are not limited to a particular political subdivision or region.

41 (2) However, no licensing or regulatory public body shall conduct a
 42 disciplinary hearing or adjudication via electronic means pursuant to this
 43 Section.

44 I. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to:

45 (1) The legislature, either house of the legislature, or any committee of
 46 the legislature or either house of the legislature.

47 (2) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education.

48 (3) The Board of Regents.

49 (4) The Board of Ethics or Ethics Adjudicatory Board.

50 (5) The State Civil Service Commission.

51 (6) The board of directors of the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance
 52 Corporation.

53 (7) The Board of Commerce and Industry.

54 (8) The board of supervisors for the Louisiana State University System,
 55 the University of Louisiana System, the Louisiana Community and Technical
 56 Colleges System, or the Southern University System.

57 (9) Any parish board of election supervisors.

1 **§17.2.1. Public body; member with a disability**

2 **A. Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter that requires a**
3 **member of a public body to be physically present in order to be counted for a**
4 **quorum and to participate and vote in a meeting, a member of a public body**
5 **who has a disability recognized by the Americans with Disabilities Act shall be**
6 **allowed to participate and vote in a meeting via electronic means as defined in**
7 **R.S. 42:17.2.**

8 **B. Each public body shall adopt rules, regulations, and procedures to**
9 **facilitate the requirements of Subsection A of this Section.**
