WHEREAS, Senator Pope has served as a member of the Capital Region, Northshore, and Republican delegations and the Rural Caucus; and

WHEREAS, prior to his legislative service, Senator Pope spent decades as a respected and beloved educator in Livingston Parish; he served as a teacher, coach, principal, assistant superintendent, and superintendent and was named the Louisiana Superintendent of the Year in 2000; and

WHEREAS, additionally, in recognition of his many contributions to education in his community, the courtyard at Southside Junior High School, where he served as the first principal upon the school's opening in 1979, was named in his honor; and

WHEREAS, J. Rogers Pope will forever have a special place in the chronicles of the history of Louisiana as one of the state's most outstanding public servants; and

WHEREAS, as he prepares to embark on the next chapter of his life, Senator Pope merits a sincere measure of commendation for his singular contributions as an educator and legislator.
