Proposed resolution memorializes Congress to pass the Disaster Mitigation and Tax Parity Act of 2021 (H.R. 4675 and S. 2432 introduced in the 117th Congress) or legislation identical or similar to exclude payments received from state-based catastrophe loss mitigation programs from taxable income.
