Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Original House Bill No. 287
by Representative Cormier

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 3, after "initial" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 4 in its
3 entirety and insert in lieu thereof "estimate and certain supporting documents to an insured;
4 to authorize electronic submission thereof; and to provide for related matters."5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 "(5) Relative to first-party property damage claims, upon receipt from an
8 onsite field adjuster, An an insurer shall issue a copy of furnish to the insurer's
9 insured the field adjuster adjuster's report, relative to the insured's property damage
10 claim, to the insured within fifteen days of receiving a request for such from the
11 insured unaltered initial estimate and supporting documents via an online portal or
12 electronic mail address on file. Supporting documents include but are not limited to
13 bids, plans, measurements, drawings, engineer reports, contractor reports,
14 photographs, video recordings, statements, or documents that are not legally
15 privileged that the insurer prepared, had prepared, or used during its adjustment of
16 the insured's claim. An insured who does not create an online account or provide an
17 electronic mail address to the insurer shall submit a request to the insurer to gain
18 access to the unaltered initial estimate and supporting documents. An insurer may
19 keep confidential adjuster notes, logs, and any documents prepared in conjunction
20 with a fraud investigation."
