2 To enact R.S. 33:2476.7, relative to the city of Monroe; to provide relative to the municipal 3 fire and police civil service board; to provide relative to the office of board secretary; 4 to provide relative to the employment, salary, and duties of the secretary; and to 5 provide for related matters. Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published 6 7 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of 8 Louisiana. 9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 10 Section 1. R.S. 33:2476.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 11 §2476.7. Municipal fire and police civil service board; board secretary; city of 12 Monroe A. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 33:2476(L)(1)(c), in the city of 13 14 Monroe, the board may fill the office of secretary for the municipal fire and police 15 civil service board by employing on a part-time basis any person the board deems 16 qualified. The board may pay any such person a salary not to exceed sixteen 17 hundred dollars per month which salary shall be approved by the municipal 18 governing authority. 19 B. The duties of the secretary shall be assigned by the board.

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2023; if vetoed by the governor
2	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
3	2023, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
