**LOCAL GOVERNMENT: Provides with respect to certain permits required by parishes and municipalities.**

DIGEST

Proposed law prohibits parish and municipal governing authorities from requiring any person, who is an account holder with an authorized utility provider and whose account is being charged by the provider for electric services provided to a dwelling located in the state to acquire a permit to change the name of the person listed as the account holder.

Proposed law provides that nothing in proposed law will prohibit regulatory inspection or enforcement regarding on-site sewerage disposal systems, nor will it prohibit a parish or municipal governing authority from collecting past due utility debt.
