EMPLOYMENT: Creates a task force to study and make recommendations for designating a certain percentage of man-hours in any apprenticeable occupation to registered apprentices for certain construction and capital projects

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To create a task force to study and make recommendations to determine whether designating
3	a certain percentage of man-hours in any apprenticeable occupation to registered
4	apprentices for certain construction and capital projects would be beneficial for this
5	state.
6	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Workforce Commission utilizes the Registered
7	Apprenticeship program, which is a federally regulated program, to connect individuals
8	seeking to acquire new skills and employment with employers seeking qualified job
9	applicants; and
10	WHEREAS, the Registered Apprenticeship program, herein referred to as "the
11	program", has recognized partnerships with various businesses, employer and industry
12	associations, labor management organizations, state and local workforce development
13	agencies and programs, two- and four-year colleges that offer associate and bachelor's
14	degrees in conjunction with apprenticeship certificates, community leaders and economic
15	development organizations, and even the United States military; and
16	WHEREAS, the program is beneficial to individuals who seek and elect to
17	participate in this program; and
18	WHEREAS, the program allows individuals to become apprentices and provides
19	them the opportunity to receive hands-on experience and classroom training in order to
20	ensure that they become proficient in their selected occupations; and

4	establish a task force to study and make recommendations to determine whether designating		
5	a certain percentage of man-hours in any apprenticeable occupation to registered apprentices		
6	for certain construction and capital projects would be beneficial for this state.		
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership of the task force shall be as		
8	follows:		
9	(1)	The secretary of the Louisiana Workforce Commission or his designee.	
10	(2)	One representative from the Louisiana Association of Business and Industry.	
11	(3)	One representative from the Louisiana AFL-CIO.	
12	(4)	One representative from the Associated Builders and Contractors of	
13	Louisiana.		
14	(5)	One representative from the Louisiana Associated General Contractors.	
15	(6)	The speaker of the House of Representatives or his designee.	
16	(7)	The president of the Senate or his designee.	
17	(8)	The chairman of the House Committee on Commerce or his designee.	
18	(9)	The chairman of the Senate Committee on Commerce or his designee.	
19	(10)	One representative from the Louisiana Community and Technical College	
20	System.		
21	BE IT	FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Workforce Commission shall	
22	provide staff support as needed by the task force.		
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall convene its first meeting by		
24	September 1, 2023, and shall meet as frequently as it deems necessary for the timely		
25	performance of its duties.		
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at the first meeting, the members of the task		
27	force shall elect a chairperson, who shall preside over the task force.		
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the task force shall serve without		
29	compensation.

2	its findings and recommendations to the Legislature of Louisiana not later than February 1,		
3	2024.		
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall do all of the following:		
5	(1) Assess the current number of registered apprentices within this state.		
6	(2) Assess the current number of businesses and organizations that participate in		
7	the Registered Apprenticeship program within this state.		
8	(3) Assess the benefits and drawbacks, if any, to specific employers who would		
9	be required to designate a certain percentage of man-hours in any apprenticeable occupation		
10	to registered apprentices for certain construction and capital projects.		
11	(4) Recommend legislation and policy changes for the 2024 Regular Session of		
12	the Legislature.		
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the		
14	secretary of the Louisiana Workforce Commission, the president of the Louisiana		
15	Association of Business and Industry, the president of the Louisiana AFL-CIO, the		
16	chairperson of the Associated Builders and Contractors of Louisiana, the system president		
17	of the Louisiana Community and Technical College System, and the chief executive officer		
18	of the Louisiana Associated General Contractors.
