4	WHEREAS, students and instructors of martial arts training develop the mental
5	attitudes and moral characteristics of discipline, confidence, respect, persistence,
6	self -control, and sportsmanship; and
7	WHEREAS, the students and instructors train year round on a weekly basis to be able
8	to participate in either the beginners, intermediate, or advanced categories at tournaments;

10	WHEREAS, competing in martial arts allow students and instructors to employ a
11	variety of skills or practices; and
12	WHEREAS, competing in martial arts also allows students and instructors to push
13	the limits of their potential, knowing that their skills and abilities will be tested in front of
14	a crowd of spectators; and
15	WHEREAS, some matches in competition commonly last about two minutes, to a
16	decision, if neither contestant has scored a clean "K" point in the estimation of the judges;
