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Provides relative to the collection of certain traffic stop data by law enforcement

Under present law, all law enforcement agencies are required to report the following information relating to traffic stops: (1) the number of people stopped for traffic violations; (2) race, gender, age, and state of residence of people stopped; (3) the nature of the alleged traffic violation; (4) whether a citation was issued, an arrest made, or a search conducted as a result of the stop; (5) if a search occurred, the type of search conducted, the legal basis for the search, and contraband or property seized; and (6) the number of people stopped for certain wireless communication and cell phone infractions. Present law provides for an exemption from reporting if a law enforcement agency has a written policy against racial profiling. Proposed law removes the LA State Police from the exception. Therefore, State Police will provide information related to all traffic stops conducted by troopers. Proposed law effective 1/01/2024.
