## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The LFO does not anticipate a direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Present law allows for local education agencies (LEAs) to participate in a local review process of textbooks and other instructional materials. Proposed law requires LEAs have at least two teachers who hold the designation of Teacher Leader Advisor certify textbooks and materials are aligned with Louisiana state content standards, using the rubric approved by the Louisiana Department of Education (LDE). No more than 50% of advisors conducting the review can be employed by the LEA. LDE reports there will be no additional costs to the department to comply with proposed law.
