REDISTRICTING Provides for transparency and community engagement in redistricting. (gov sig)

Proposed law requires:

- 1) a local governing body to hold a series of public hearings prior to the adoption of any redistricting plan
- 2) hearings to be held throughout the state prior to the consideration of any statewide redistricting plan
- 3) all hearings to be streamed online in real time
- 4) the legislature to establish, maintain, and update a redistricting website

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed law provides that meetings must be held throughout the state prior to the consideration of any statewide redistricting plan. Both the House and Senate already conduct these hearings, so this bill is not anticipated to add any additional cost.

Note: The Senate indicates that historically they have not been charged a fee to use the facilities where the meetings were held. To the extent that they are charged a fee in the future, there will be some costs associated with using those facilities.
