## CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides that contribution limits are applicable per calendar year rather than per election (Item #8)

**Abstract:** Provides that campaign contribution limits apply per calendar year, rather than per election.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 18:1505.2) imposes limits on the amount of campaign contributions that a single source may make to a candidate per election in which the candidate participates.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the application of the limits on campaign contributions <u>from</u> per election <u>to</u> per calendar year.
