1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 4, at the end of line 22, insert the following:

3 **"Any order issued pursuant to a hearing that was not conducted in compliance**
4 **with the notice requirements of this Subsection shall be null and void. The**
5 **registered victim representative, the district attorney, and the attorney general**
6 **may appeal any order issued pursuant to a hearing that was not conducted in**
7 **compliance with the notice requirements of this Subsection and to seek any**
8 **available relief, including injunctive relief. Any appeal pursuant to this**
9 **Subparagraph shall suspend the order of the Board of Pardons or committee**
10 **on parole pending final adjudication of the appeal."**

12 On page 5, line 2, after "schedule" insert "subsequent"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 3

14 On page 6, line 1, after "committee" insert "before an offender's actual release from
15 custody onto parole supervision"

17 On page 6, line 3, after "parole" insert "before the offender's actual release from custody
18 onto parole supervision"
