



removal or destruction of a booking photograph is subject to prosecution under present law relative to the crime of extortion.

Present law provides that if the remove-for-pay publication or website does not remove and destroy the booking photograph, the remove-for-pay publication or website will be liable for all costs, including reasonable attorney fees, resulting from any legal action that the individual brings in relation to the failure of the remove-for-pay publication or remove-for-pay website to remove and destroy the booking photograph.

Present law defines "booking photograph" and "remove-for-pay publication or website" for purposes of present law.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective August 1, 2024.
