Abstract: Provides relative to the disposition of a motor vehicle used in a crime of violence.

Proposed law provides that in addition to any other penalties provided by law, any person who owns a motor vehicle and uses his motor vehicle while engaged in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of a crime of violence as defined in present law (R.S. 14:2(B)) shall, upon motion of the prosecuting district attorney, have his motor vehicle seized and impounded for not more than 30 days upon conviction or disposition of the case.

Proposed law defines the term "motor vehicle".
