Abstract: Provides term limits for parish presidents, mayors, and parish and municipal governing authorities.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> prohibits a parish president, member of a parish governing authority, mayor, or member of a municipal governing authority who has been elected to serve in any such office for more than two and one-half terms in three consecutive terms, that service being during a term of office that began on or after Jan. 1, 2025, from being elected to the same office for the succeeding term. Further prohibits any such official who is in office on Jan. 1, 2025, and who has been elected four successive times to serve in that office from being elected to the same office for the succeeding term.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held November 5, 2024.
