SB 95 Original

Present law provides that a person who takes possession of a strayed animal must notify the Livestock Brand Commission by certified mail return receipt requested.

Present law provides that costs and expenses charged by a person holding a strayed animal will commence on the date the notice is mailed.

Proposed law retains present law and further provides that notice can be made by electronic submission through the department's website and expenses will commence on the date notice is electronically submitted.

Present law provides that if the commission is unable to determine ownership within 10 days of receipt of the notice, the strayed animal will be advertised and sold in accordance with law.

Proposed law retains present law and clarifies that the law in which animals will be advertised and sold under is R.S. 3:3006.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
