**Abstract:** Removes the need for a hunting license for the taking of feral hogs, armadillos, coyotes, nutria, and beavers, and removes the requirement of notification to the sheriff of an intention to attempt to take outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver.

Present law requires a license in order to take an outlaw quadruped. Proposed law modifies present law by removing the requirement of a license in order to take an outlaw quadruped, nutria, or beaver.

Present law requires any person attempting to take outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver to notify the sheriff of the parish in which the property is located of his intention to attempt to take outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver within 24 hours prior to the attempted taking or immediately upon taking the animal. Proposed law removes the requirement of notification to the sheriff.
