Abstract: Removes the mandate that the division of archives, records management, and history of the Dept. of State serve as the centralized document conversion center for the state.

<u>Present law</u> requires the division of archives, records management, and history of the Dept. of State to serve as the centralized document conversion center for the state. Requires state agencies that lack adequate paper systems to either contract with the division for conversion services or to obtain the division's approval to contract with another vendor or to purchase another conversion system.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes rather than requires the division to serve as the centralized document conversion center for the state, makes technical changes, and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
