AN ACT

To enact R.S. 40:1379.1.3(D) and 1379.1.4(F), relative to carrying of concealed firearms; to provide relative to carrying of concealed firearms by qualified law enforcement officers and qualified retired law enforcement officers; to provide relative to penalties for violation of concealed carry provisions; to provide relative to authority of attorney general to bring civil actions; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:1379.1.3(D) and 1379.1.4(F) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1379.1.3. Carrying of concealed firearms by qualified law enforcement officers

* * *

D. A business organization operating a venue shall be subject to a civil fine of one thousand dollars per occurrence for each violation of the provisions of this Section. Each violation of this Section shall constitute a separate offense. The attorney general shall have the authority to bring a civil action arising out of any violation of the provisions of this Section, in addition to any other authority granted by the Constitution of Louisiana and laws of this state.
