AN ACT

To enact R.S. 22:1339, relative to cancellation of homeowner's policies; to provide a widow an extension to pay the premiums for a homeowner's policy; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:1339 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1339. Homeowner's insurance extension to pay premium; recently deceased insured
An insurer providing property, casualty, or liability insurance shall provide a recently widowed insured an extension of time not more than six months to pay any premiums due for his homeowner's insurance policy.
