Provides for the sentencing of a juvenile after adjudication. (8/1/24)

Current law mandates that a juvenile, 14 years of age or older at the time of the offense, adjudicated delinquent of felony-grade first degree murder or second degree murder, be placed in secure placement with the Department of Public Safety & Corrections (DPS&C) without the benefit of probation, suspension, imposition, or execution of sentence until the juvenile turns 21 years of age; mandates that a motion for modification of a disposition be filed and a contradictory hearing be set no sooner than 30 days from the date of notice to the district attorney, and that in granting a motion for modification of a disposition, the court **must** find that the child poses a reduced risk to the community based on several considerations.
