1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after ""enact"" delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S. 463.230,
3 through 463.242, relative to motor vehicle special"

5 On page 1, line 3, after "of the" change ""Share the Road"" to ""3` for Cyclists""

7 On page 1, line 5, after "Academy," insert ""Icitte on parle français", "Bienvenue en

9 "United States Submarine Veterans", "Leesville High School Alumni", and "Humane
10 Society of Louisiana""

12 On page 1, line 9, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.

21 On page 2, line 2, after "words" change "Share the Road"" to "3` for Cyclists""

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 4, after line 28, insert the following:

24 "§463.234. Special prestige license plate; "Icitte on parle français"

25 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
26 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Icitte on
27 parle français" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants
28 for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
29 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

30 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Télé-Louisiane, to select the
31 color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3).
32 The design shall include the words "Icitte on parle français".

33 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
34 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

35 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars

1 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 2 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 3 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 4 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 5 administrative costs.

6 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 7 to Télé-Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to assist
 8 the Télé-Louisiane French programming LPB.

9 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 10 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

 12 §463.235. Special prestige license plate; "Bienvenue en Louisiane"

13 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 14 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the
 15 "Bienvenue en Louisiane " plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
 16 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
 17 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

18 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,
 19 to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
 20 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bienvenue en Louisiane".

21 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 22 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

23 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 24 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 25 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 26 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 27 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 28 administrative costs.

29 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 30 to L'Assemblée de la Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be
 31 used to assist L'Assemblée de la Louisiane fund initiative to promote French in
 32 Louisiana and expand French immersion in schools .

33 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 34 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

 36 §463.236. Special prestige license plate; "Lâche Pas"

37 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 38 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Lâche
 39 Pas" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
 40 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
 41 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

42 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,
 43 to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
 44 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Lache Pas".

45 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 46 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

47 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 48 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 49 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 50 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 51 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 52 administrative costs.

53 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 54 to L'Assemblée de Louisiane . The monies received from the royalty fees shall be
 55 used to assist Lâche Pas Vermilion cultural heritage program .

56 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 57 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

58 §463.237. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Indian"

1 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 2 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou
 3 Indian" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
 4 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
 5 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

6 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to
 7 select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
 8 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Indian".

9 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 10 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

11 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 12 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 13 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 14 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 15 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 16 administrative costs.

17 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 18 to Ecole Pointe-au-Chien. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used
 19 to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

20 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 21 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

22 §463.238. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Cajun"

23 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 24 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou
 25 Cajun" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
 26 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
 27 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

28 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to
 29 select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
 30 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Cajun".

31 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 32 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

33 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 34 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 35 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 36 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 37 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 38 administrative costs.

39 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 40 to Ecole Pointe-au-Chien. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used
 41 to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

42 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 43 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

44 §463.239. Special prestige license plate; "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier"

45 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 46 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Je chasse
 47 au Grand Chenier" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
 48 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
 49 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

50 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane
 51 in consultation with local residents of Cameron Parish, to select the color and design
 52 of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall
 53 include the words "Je chasse au Grand Chenier".

54 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 55 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

56 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars

1 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 2 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 3 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 4 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 5 administrative costs.

6 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 7 to L'Assemblée de Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be
 8 used to assist the creation of a French immersion program in Cameron Parish.

9 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 10 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section."

11 §463.240. Special prestige license plate; "United States Submarine Veterans"

12 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 13 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "United
 14 States Submarine Veterans" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
 15 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
 16 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

17 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the United States Submarine
 18 Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc., to select the color and design of the plate,
 19 provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the
 20 words "United States Submarine Veterans".

21 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 22 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

23 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 24 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 25 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 26 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 27 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 28 administrative costs.

29 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 30 to the treasurer of the United States Submarine Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc.
 31 The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to provide scholarships for
 32 children.

33 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 34 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section."

35 §463.241. Special prestige license plate; "Leesville High School Alumni"

36 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
 37 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as "Leesville
 38 High School " plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for
 39 such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
 40 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

41 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Alumni Association
 42 Executive Board, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in
 43 compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Leesville
 44 High School Alumni".

45 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
 46 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

47 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
 48 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
 49 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
 50 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
 51 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
 52 administrative costs.

53 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
 54 to Leesville High School Alumni Association. The monies received from the royalty
 55 fees shall be used to provide scholarships.

56 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
 57 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section."

1 §463.242. Special prestige license plate; "Humane Society of Louisiana"

2 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
3 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as "Humane
4 Society of Louisiana" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
5 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
6 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

7 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Humane Society of
8 Louisiana, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance
9 with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Humane Society of
10 Louisiana".

11 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
12 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

13 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
14 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
15 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
16 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
17 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
18 administrative costs.

19 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
20 to the treasurer of the Humane Society of Louisiana. The monies received from the
21 royalty fees shall be used to fund spay and neuter programs to help with current
22 overpopulation of animals."

23 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
24 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section."
