AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 13, insert "**The provisions of this Subpart apply to all lines**
3 **of property and casualty insurance.**"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the beginning of line 14, insert "B."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, line 23, change "**B.**" to "**C.**"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 3, line 1, change "**C.**" to "**D.**"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 3, at the beginning of line 13, change "**D.**" to "**E.**"

AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 3, and the beginning of line 16, delete "**E.**" and insert "F."

AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page on page 3, at the beginning of line 19, delete "**F.**" and insert "G."

AMENDMENT NO. 8

17 On page 3, between lines 22 and 23, insert "* * *"

AMENDMENT NO. 9

19 On page 3, line 28, after "Subpart," delete "it" and insert "**he**" and delete "such" and insert
20 "**the**"

AMENDMENT NO. 10

22 On page 3, line 29, delete "furnish" and insert "**provide**"

AMENDMENT NO. 11

24 On page 4, line 18, delete "not become effective" and insert "**become ineffective as of the**
25 **date the written notice is sent, at which time the insurer's or rating organization's most**
26 **recently approved rate filing shall resume effectiveness.**"

AMENDMENT NO. 12

28 On page 5, after line 2, add the following:

1 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the
2 governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for
3 bills to become law without signature of the governor as provided by Article
4 III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor
5 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective
6 on the day following such approval."
