ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT. Repeals Port Development Advisory Commission. (7/1/24)

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 36:108(C)(8) as enacted by Act No. 459 of the 2023 Regular Session and
3 Chapter 44 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S.
4 51:2701, relative to the Port Development Advisory Commission; to provide relative
5 to the office of port development; to repeal the Port Development Advisory
6 Commission; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 36:108(C)(8) as enacted by Act 459 of the 2023 Regular Session is
9 hereby repealed.

10 Section 2. Chapter 44 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
11 comprised of R.S. 51:2701, is hereby repealed.

12 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024; if vetoed by the governor
13 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day
14 following such approval by the legislature or July 1, 2024, whichever is later.
