Abstract: Provides for the confidentiality of certain records pertaining to the schedule, meetings, events, and transportation of a statewide elected official other than the governor.

Proposed law provides that any record of the office of lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney general, treasurer, commissioner of agriculture, or commissioner of insurance pertaining to the schedule of the official or of an employee of the office that contains security details that if made public may impair the safety of the official may be held confidential for a period not to exceed seven days following a scheduled event.

Proposed law authorizes the official to keep a record concerning a meeting or event that the official attends and transportation thereto confidential for up to seven days after the occurrence of the meeting or event. Does not make confidential all records concerning a meeting or event that the official attends and transportation related thereto.
